

SUNNYVALE EL CAMINO REAL CORRIDOR SPECIFIC PLAN ADVISORY COMMITTEE APPLICATION

Applications Due July 13, 2015 by 5 p.m.

The City is inviting applications from Sunnyvale residents, property owners and business owners to serve on a community advisory committee for the preparation of the Sunnyvale El Camino Real Corridor Specific Plan. The planning process will involve active participation from the community, and serving on the Sunnyvale El Camino Real Corridor Plan Advisory Committee (ECPAC) will be just one of many opportunities for the community to get involved.

The ECPAC will play a key role in providing input and a balance of perspectives during the planning process. The ECPAC is intended to represent a broad cross-section of the community and the multiple interests of the Study Area (see attached map). Members of the ECPAC will be appointed by a Council Subcommittee of three City Councilmembers. The ECPAC will be responsible for reviewing information, providing feedback on topics, recommending priorities, and working to represent the various interests of the community. Members of the ECPAC will be appointed by the Council Subcommittee to fill the following categories:

The ECPAC will have about 6 core meetings within the estimated 15- to 18-month project schedule; supplemental meetings may be necessary depending on the progress of the committee. The City anticipates the first ECPAC meeting to be held in August 2015. A more detailed schedule will be determined when the project work plan is

finalized. Members will need to allow 2-3 hours for the first meeting and then 2 hours for each regular meeting.

Please note that selected Advisory Committee members will not receive any financial compensation for their service. It is important that each member attend all meetings throughout the process.



