



**Council Meeting: February 26, 2008**

**SUBJECT: Ratification of Council Intergovernmental Committee  
Appointments**

**REPORT IN BRIEF**

In January of each year, City Council fills a number of positions for intergovernmental assignments. Throughout the year, Councilmembers may be appointed to additional intergovernmental assignments. Since January, Mayor Spitaleri has been appointed to: 1) the National League of Cities (NLC) Public Safety and Crime Prevention (PSCP) Policy and Advocacy Committee. Appointments made by outside agencies are subject to Council ratification.

A confirmation letter from the League of California Cities – the appointing agency – is attached (Attachment A). Staff recommends Council ratification of this appointment prior to the National League of Cities' Congressional City Conference in Washington, D.C. (March 8 – 12).

**BACKGROUND**

The City Council annually appoints members to a variety of intergovernmental agencies in order to represent the City's interests and to influence policies and regulations of other agencies. Specific intergovernmental appointments are sometimes made by other agencies; the appointments are then subject to Council ratification.

**EXISTING POLICY**

**Legislative Sub Element, Goal 7.3C** Participate in intergovernmental activities, including national, state and regional groups, as a means to represent the City's interest, influence policy and legislation, and enhance awareness.

**Legislative Sub Element, Policy 7.3.C.1** Represent City policy in intergovernmental activities in accordance with adopted policy guidelines.

**Council Policy 7.3.12** City Council Appointments to Intergovernmental Agencies, City Council Subcommittees and Council or Mayor-Created Advisory Task Forces

## **DISCUSSION**

A brief description of the committee assignment follows, including designation of staff support. Attachment B is a list of the current 2008 Council Intergovernmental Relations Committee Assignments, including these new assignments.

### **Appointment to the National League of Cities' Public Safety and Crime Prevention (PSCP) Policy and Advocacy Committee**

The National League of Cities' Public Safety and Crime Prevention (PSCP) Policy and Advocacy Committee addresses topics such as crime and violence levels, delivering life-saving rescue services, preventing fires, and preparing for and responding effectively to domestic terrorism and natural disasters. The primary goal of local public safety and crime prevention efforts is to ensure that the nation's cities and towns provide a safe, healthy environment in which residents can live.

The panel meets at NLC's two annual conferences, Congressional City and Congress of Cities, and usually meets mid-year in the summer. The summer meeting is not a regular part of the annual program and not a mandatory part of the appointment.

Staff support for this assignment will be provided by James Bouziane, Lieutenant, Department of Public Safety.

There is no fiscal impact to this report.


