

**Council Meeting: June 2, 2009****SUBJECT: Public Hearing-Annual Review of Fees and Charges for Fiscal Year 2009/2010****REPORT IN BRIEF**

The current fees and charges of the City have been reviewed in accordance with the Fiscal Sub-element of the General Plan. After an extensive and detailed review of fees, adjustments have been made to the proposed Fee Schedule as necessary to ensure that all fees and charges are aligned with the cost to provide each service, except for those fees that are legally limited, market based, and in some cases, as discussed below, subsidized.

Fees that are legally limited remain unchanged. It is recommended that Development Fees remain unchanged for the upcoming fiscal year as well. These fees are currently undergoing a study to break them down by activity in order to establish the nexus between the fees we charge and our costs to perform the work. Results of the study will be incorporated as appropriate into the Fee Schedule upon Council review and approval.

In many cases, a Time/Motion study was conducted to determine if the fee needs to be adjusted. Some fees were adjusted by the increase in labor costs of the work unit that provides the service. The proposed Fee Schedule (Exhibit A of Attachment A) details all recommended fees.

BACKGROUND

Tonight's public hearing is to allow public input and comment on fees and charges that will be effective for FY 2009/2010. This hearing on the proposed fees will be followed by formal action adopting updated and new fees on June 23, 2009.

The attached Fee Schedule references all City fees, except the proposed utility rates. Fees related to Utility services (water, refuse, and sewer) are adopted by Council when the utility rates are set. This is done by a separate action. Any Council-approved changes to the utility rates will be updated in the Fee Schedule when the utility rates are adopted.

Most new fees become effective at the start of the new fiscal year on July 1, 2009. There are three exceptions: Changes to Development Processing fees (filing, accepting, reviewing, approving, or issuing of an application or permit)

and mitigation fees become effective 60 days after adoption (in accordance with §66017 of the California Government Code). The Above Ground Petroleum Storage Act hazardous materials fee will become effective January 1, 2010. Golf fees go into effect on April 1, 2010 because they are adjusted with the golf season.

EXISTING POLICY

The fiscal Sub-Element of the General Plan states that user charges and fees should be adjusted at least annually to avoid sharp changes (B.5.2), user fees should be established at levels which reflect the full cost of providing those services (B.5.4), and Council may determine whether a subsidy for any service is in the public interest (B.5.5). The annual review and adjustment of fees and charges is in accordance with these action statements.

Section 66016(a) of the California Government Code provides that, prior to levying a new fee or service charge or approving an increase in an existing fee or service charge, the City shall hold at least one public meeting at which time oral or written presentations can be made.

DISCUSSION

With the exception of golf green fees, the attached Fee Schedule does not include recreational fees. The Director of Community Services is authorized to administratively establish Activity and Facility Use Fee Schedules for recreation activities and services. The Fee Schedule shall be established based upon market conditions and City Council adopted policies to ensure fairness and accessibility while attaining fiscal self-sufficiency. These schedules shall be published and available to the public.

Staff has made adjustments to the proposed Fee Schedule as necessary to ensure that all fees and charges are aligned with the cost of service, except for those fees that are legally limited, market based or (in some cases) subsidized. Some Public Safety fees were adjusted by time and motion studies as discussed below. The proposed Fee Schedule (Exhibit A of Attachment A) details all recommended fees. For ease of administration, many fees have been rounded to the nearest logical unit.

The water, wastewater, and solid waste fees are proposed to increase by 8%, 5.5% and 7.5% respectively. The proposed fees related to water, wastewater, and solid waste services will be adopted by a separate action of the City Council. Once those fees have been approved by Council, they will be incorporated into the Citywide fee schedule.

The City's Fiscal Policy guides staff to set fees for services to recover cost where possible and legally allowed. Staff continues to ensure that all fees not legally limited, market based, or subsidized provide for full cost recovery.

The results of these efforts have been incorporated into the recommended Fee Schedule for FY 2009/2010. New fees or fees that are proposed to be adjusted by an amount other than inflation are discussed below.

New Fees

The following are new fees that have been proposed by staff for FY 2009/2010. These fees have generally been proposed to address either a new demand for service, to recover the cost resulting from a significant increase in demand for service that the City already provides, or to collect revenue for a service that has been provided at no cost, the cost of which can be legally recovered from the user of the service. Each fee has been carefully evaluated to ensure it covers the cost of providing each service.

Department of Public Safety

Hourly Inspection Fee (Carnivals and Fairs)

This fee has been reported under the Temporary Membrane Structures, Tents and Canopies section of the Fire Safety Operations Permits and is being added to the Carnival and Fair permit type to allow a fee to be charged for any required inspection.

Administrative Citation Fine

The Fire Prevention division of Public Safety issues Administrative Citations under the same authority as Community Development (Chapter 1.05 of the Sunnyvale Municipal Code). These citations are issued for Public Safety code violations. This fine is not a new fine but is being reported as new in the fee schedule under Public Safety to differentiate this fine from Community Development fines.

Background for Explosives Fire Safety Operations Permit

A fee for the required background check of explosives permit applicants is being added to the Fee Schedule. That fee has been established as a cost recovery fee and the fee is proposed to be \$84.

State Application Fee for Explosives Permits

A new fee has been added to the fee schedule for applicants that handle explosives. This fee is set at \$2 for 100 pounds or less of explosives and \$10 for more than 100 pounds of explosives. The Health & Safety Code requires that 50% of this fee be remitted to the State.

Hazardous Materials Fees-CalEPA E-Data

AB 2286 requires the electronic submittal of certain environmental data by Certified Unified Program Agencies (CUPAs) and the regulated community to

California Environmental Protection Agency (CalEPA) by 2013. The bill provides a funding mechanism for the transition to “e-reporting”. Each regulated business is required to pay \$25 per year for three years via the CUPA service charge process. This new fee is a “pass through” fee and will be submitted to the State on a quarterly basis.

Hazardous Materials Fees-Above Ground Petroleum Storage Act

The CalEPA transferred the responsibility for implementation of the Above Ground Petroleum Storage Act (APSA) to CUPAs in January of 2008. The program regulates facilities with petroleum stored in above ground tanks or drums when the aggregate quantity exceeds 1,320 gallons. A CalEPA grant was provided to offset program startup costs through December 2009. Beginning January 1, 2010 each CUPA must establish and collect a fee sufficient to pay the necessary and reasonable costs of ongoing program implementation. That fee is proposed to be \$120 per regulated facility per year.

Hazardous Materials Fees-CalARP

This is a new fee to offset the annual costs to review a previously submitted Risk Management Plan and to inspect a facility specifically for California Accidental Release Prevention Program (CalARP) compliance. This annual fee would replace the CalARP inspection hourly fee for routine inspections, which will remain in the fee schedule for non-routine inspections.

The new fee is proposed to be \$120 for Program Level 1 facilities and \$240 for Program Levels 2 and 3. Level 1 is defined as a company with the lowest risk under CalARP thresholds with regards to hazardous materials. Therefore, City staff time to review the risk management plans and inspect the facility for Level 1 companies is less than for Level 2 and Level 3 companies. Level 2 and Level 3 companies have more complex risk management plans because the materials they store pose a higher risk. Therefore, it takes more City staff time to review the plans and inspect the facility. Level 3 companies have to comply with federal requirements as well as state requirements.

Department of Public Works

On October 21, 2008 the City Council adopted an ordinance to add Chapter 9.30 (Shopping Cart Containment) to the Sunnyvale Municipal Code. The Public Works Department brought this item before the Council to address the challenges of dealing with abandoned shopping carts on public or private property. These abandoned carts create conditions that promote blight and interfere with pedestrian and vehicular traffic within the City. This Chapter will be enforced by the Public Works and Community Development departments as a joint effort. Two new fees and one fine are proposed to be added to the Fee Schedule as a result.

Public Works is proposing a shopping cart retrieval fee and a containment plan review fee. Any company that fails to retrieve its abandoned cart(s) after receiving the three-day notice by the City shall pay the City's costs for retrieving the cart and providing notification to the owner. This cost recovery fee is proposed to be \$100. The containment plan review fee is proposed to be \$195. The City Council also approved a fine to any owner who fails to retrieve abandoned cart(s) in excess of three times during a six-month period. That fine is \$50 for each occurrence. Neighborhood Preservation will follow up on any code violations pertaining to cart and store signage similar to how they handle other Zoning Code violations.

Non-Standard Fee and Charge Adjustments

The following fees were adjusted by an amount different than inflation. Proposed subsidized fees are also discussed in this section.

Department of Community Development

Administrative Citations

Neighborhood Preservation presented a Study Issue to Council in December regarding taking a more aggressive approach to Code Enforcement. The citation structure changed from a four tier to a three tier structure, the timeframe within each tier was reduced from 36 months to 12 months and all of the fees within the structure were raised as a result. The new fines are \$100 for the first violation, \$200 for the second violation occurring within a 12 month period, and \$500 for the third and subsequent violation occurring within a 12 month period. In addition, the time frame for appealing a citation was reduced from 30 days to 15 days.

Below Market Rate (BMR) Program Fees

There are three fees under the Below Market Rate housing program. These fees were developed for services provided to process BMR purchase applications, BMR re-finance requests, and certification of eligibility for BMR renters. Staff reviews and verifies the documentation submitted on eligibility and preference points to purchase a BMR. With the submittal of their application to purchase, an applicant pays a non-refundable filing fee for processing their application.

City staff time is also required to process a refinance. Staff works with the applicant from the initial request until escrow is closed and the recorded Deed of Trust is received.

In the BMR Rental Program, each property owner/manager maintains a waiting list for their property. Each applicant is granted preference points to determine their priority placement on the waiting list. The City issues a "Certificate of Eligibility" to each applicant so that there is uniformity in the review of documentation and assignment of preference points using the City's database.

Staff recommends that all fees under this program remain unchanged. These fees are reasonable, within the same range as fees charged by other entities, and are below the actual cost for processing. These program fees are subsidized by other housing fees.

Department of Libraries

The majority of Library fees are either in sync with the fees and fines charged by the Silicon Valley Library System or they are set to recover costs. Those that are deemed to be cost recovery have been studied. A detailed analysis was conducted to ensure that fees reflect both the direct and indirect cost of providing the service. No change is recommended at this time with the following one exception.

The current processing fee for lost or damaged paperbacks, boardbooks, magazines, or pamphlets when an acceptable replacement is provided is being increased from \$1.60 to \$1.75 to attain full cost recovery.

Department of Community Services

General Activity and Recreation Fees

The Director of Community Services sets Activity and Facility Use Fee Schedules (other than golf fees, which require Council approval) based on market conditions and City Council adopted policies. The schedules are published at least annually by the Department of Community Services, and will be made available to the public.

Golf Fees

To avoid having fee changes in the middle of the golfing season, golf fees go into effect on April 1 of every year. Since most other fee changes become effective with the start of the new fiscal year, proposed golf fees for future years are presented for Council's consideration ten months in advance.

Golf fees are market based and staff has completed the usual Market Survey of Golf Fees (please see attachment B) that provides an overview of basic weekday and weekend fees and a comparison with the Sunnyvale fees for each course.

Department of Public Safety

As part of the budget preparation process, a detailed analysis of all Public Safety fees was again performed to ensure that fees reflect both the direct and indirect costs of providing the service. Many of the Public Safety fees are proposed to be adjusted for inflation. Those fees have been adjusted by the increase in labor costs of the work unit that provides the service. Fees that are

not legally limited but left unchanged and fees adjusted by an amount other than inflation are discussed below.

Applicant Fingerprint Fee

A time/motion study indicated that this fee should be adjusted from \$61 to \$65 to reflect the current cost of processing fingerprints.

Vehicle Mechanical or Registration Violation Citation Correction (Fix-It Ticket Signoff)

Customers routinely come to the Department of Public Safety to have the desk officer sign off on a "Fix It Ticket". These citations, which may be issued by any law enforcement agency, including the Highway Patrol, are issued for minor mechanical or registration violations, such as a broken light or missing registration sticker, and are intended to ensure that the customer fixes the issue with their vehicle. In order to avoid further penalties, recipients of these citations must have a police officer verify that the violation has been corrected.

A few years ago, this service was provided free of charge. In 2006, two fees for this service were introduced: a fee for residents and a fee for non-residents. The fee for residents has been subsidized in the past. Staff is proposing that the fee for residents no longer be subsidized. A full cost recovery of this service resulted in a proposed fee of \$29 for both residents and non-residents.

Second Hand Dealer/Pawnbroker Permit

A time/motion study was performed on these permits and that study indicates that the fee for the new permits should be decreased by \$1.00 for the one owner businesses and the permit fee for additional owners should be decreased by \$2.00. The proposed fees are \$271 and \$107 respectively. The permit renewal fee increased by \$1 to \$168.

The Department of Justice new application and renewal application fees remain unchanged at \$201 and \$10 respectively.

Firearms Sales Permits

These fees are proposed to be adjusted to be fully cost recoverable. The fee for a new permit is proposed to increase from \$197 to \$200. The fee for a permit renewal is proposed to increase from \$128 to \$132.

Firearms Seizure Fees

This fee is proposed to be adjusted to be fully cost recoverable. The fee for the seizure of 1 to 5 firearms is scheduled to increase from \$208 to \$217.

Officer Contract Overtime

There are two fees associated with Officer Contract Overtime: One for non-profit organizations (schools, churches, etc.) and one for any other type of

organization. The fee is calculated to include budgeted overtime costs plus indirect costs of department and Citywide overhead. This fee is proposed to be discounted for non-profits by the amount of the indirect costs (\$18) but assessed at full value for all other types of organizations. The fee is proposed to be discounted for non-profits to encourage proactive utilization of Public Safety's services for their events so that regular Public Safety resources can best be deployed to maintain routine operations.

Alarm User Permit

It is recommended that this fee remain unchanged for the upcoming fiscal year. The permitting process is scheduled to be fully implemented within the next few months and this fee will be reviewed after full implementation.

False Alarms

These fees are designed to be punitive in order to reduce the amount of time that officers spend responding to repeated false alarms. Each tier within the false alarm fee schedule was increased last year. It is recommended that these fees remain unchanged for the upcoming fiscal year because the fees are working to serve as a deterrent as intended.

Vehicle Release Fees

A time and motion study on these fees indicates that that impound and towing fees should be increased from \$182 to \$193.

Adult Entertainment and Massage Establishment Fees

A time and motion study indicates that these fees should be increased as follows:

Taxicab Franchises

Staff is recommending that the City no longer subsidize the Taxicab Franchise fee. A time/motion study was performed on each fee in order to determine the City's full cost of providing each service. The table below shows the current fees and the proposed fees.

Vehicle Fee	\$ 116	\$180

It should be noted that although the franchise fee is going up, the quarterly vehicle fee is decreasing. The amount of time spent on inspecting vehicles and processing paperwork has decreased. Since the franchise fee is paid every other year and the vehicle fee is quarterly, it is anticipated that this change will be revenue neutral.

Fire Safety Operations Permits

California Fire Code requires the inspection and permitting of certain facilities and operations which, if unregulated, could pose a risk to the life or safety of the general public. The code further allows for the collection of fees for the permits with the exception of certain types of facilities. Several years ago, the Fire Safety Operations Permits were determined to be considerably understated and the fees were raised more than 50% over the next three years (FY 2006/2007 to FY 2008/2009) to move toward cost recovery. As significant increases have been made over the past few years, staff is recommending only increasing the fees 3.8% for FY 2009/2010. This increase will not close the funding gap. However, it will ensure the funding gap does not increase. As a number of these permit fees impact small businesses, staff does not recommend attempting to further close the revenue gap until the economic climate improves.

Animal Licensing, Impound, and Boarding Fees

These fees are market based and are not intended to be full cost recovery. Staff believes that to set them to recover cost would jeopardize the program's mission of providing services for the general welfare of the community and preclude the department from being able to regulate the animal population in response to the legal guidelines set forth in the Health and Safety Code, the Food & Agriculture Code, the Government Code and our own Municipal Code.

Department of Public Works

Traffic Control Fees

The setting of temporary traffic control fees was approved by Council resolution on March 30, 2004 and staff recommends no changes to these fees at this time. The fee for traffic control devices for neighborhood block parties is \$25 if the City delivers and/or picks up the devices. This fee becomes a refundable deposit if the devices are picked up and returned by a block party

representative. The original proposed fee was \$100. However, this fee was reduced to \$25 during Council consideration and is therefore subsidized per Council direction. Staff recommends no increase to this fee at this time.

The other subsidized fee is the Lakewood Parade, which is defined as a Type 2 function. The standard fee for a Type 2 event is \$250. This event is limited to a fee of \$100 if a representative picks up and returns the traffic control devices, making this a subsidized fee. The amount of the subsidy is \$150.

FISCAL IMPACT

Recommended adjustments to these fees have been incorporated into the recommended FY 2009/2010 Budget and Long Term Financial Plan. Exhibit A of Attachment A presents the proposed Fee Schedule for FY 2009/2010, reflecting proposed fees and charges. Any increases are necessary to reflect the rising cost of providing services.

PUBLIC CONTACT

Public contact was made by posting the Council agenda on the City's official-notice bulletin board outside City Hall, in the Council Chambers lobby, in the Office of the City Clerk, at the Library, Senior Center, Community Center and Department of Public Safety; posting the agenda and report on the City's Web site; and making the report available at the Library and the Office of the City Clerk. Notice of the public hearing on the proposed fees and charges was published in the Sunnyvale Sun on May 13 and May 20. Notice was sent to the Building Industry Association and the Tri County Division of the California Apartment Association, which requested notice pursuant to the Government Code. Boards and commissions wishing to make comments, suggestions, or recommendations may testify at tonight's public hearing.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the public hearing be held to meet the requirements of the City Charter and the California Government Code. Council should provide direction to staff on any fee requiring further review prior to the budget adoption on June 23, 2009.

RESOLUTION NO. _____

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYVALE FIXING AND ESTABLISHING FEES, RATES, AND CHARGES FOR GOODS AND SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE CITY OF SUNNYVALE

WHEREAS, the City Council is empowered to impose reasonable fees, rates, and charges for municipal services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYVALE THAT:

1. The schedule of charges attached and incorporated as Exhibit "A" are hereby established.

2. All provisions of prior City Council resolutions establishing fees which conflict with the terms hereof are hereby superseded and rescinded.

3. The establishment of rates herein is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 21080(b)(8) and the adoption of this resolution is for the purposes of (1) meeting operating expenses, including employee wage rates and fringe benefits; (2) purchasing or leasing supplies, equipment or materials; (3) meeting financial reserve needs and requirements; (4) obtaining funds for capital projects, necessary to maintain service within the existing service areas; and (5) obtaining funds necessary to maintain intra-city transfers.

4. This resolution shall be effective upon adoption, and shall be operative commencing July 1, 2009, unless specifically provided for otherwise in this resolution. Development process fees and Mitigation Fees become effective sixty (60) days after adoption in accordance with §66017 of California Government Code. Golf Fees become effective on April 1, 2010. Above Ground Petroleum Storage Act (APSA) Annual Fee becomes effective January 1, 2010.

In the event the City retains a consultant to assist in preparation of the EIR, the applicant shall deposit an amount to be determined by the Director of Community Development based upon that official's estimate of the cost of preparation.

If the costs of preparation exceed the amount of the above deposit, the Director shall notify the applicant who shall, within five days of such notice, deposit additional amounts necessary to cover costs of preparation. If costs of preparation are less than the amount deposited, any amounts remaining upon certification of the EIR shall be refunded to the applicant. Any applicant who desires to proceed directly to the preparation of a draft EIR may do so without the payment of a fee for review and initial assessment upon payment of the fee for preparation costs, review, and required filings for an EIR.

The fee for copies of documents prepared pursuant to this resolution shall be the standard fee charged by the City for copies of like documents, provided that no fee shall be charged another unit of government required to review any document requested by it.

The fee or fees set hereby shall be in addition to any other fee required by law. Postage charges will be added if documents are mailed.

- (1) The purpose of the water and sewer connection charges is to assure payment by developers of their pro-rata share of the escalated cost of the City's water and sanitary sewer system.
- (2) The charge will be used to reimburse the City for the owner or developer's fair share of the use of the water system and sanitary sewer systems.
- (3) There is a reasonable relationship between the use of the fees, the need for a water system, the need for a wastewater treatment plant, and the types of development projects upon which the fee is imposed. All development projects create varying needs for the consumption of water which cannot be fulfilled unless the project is connected to the municipal water system to assure an adequate supply of water to each project, and all development projects generate sewage and create the need for sewage conveyance, disposal and treatment. The degree to which each project is charged is based upon factors related to degree of potential usage, such as type and size of projects and number of units and calculations of the escalated cost of the City's sanitary sewer system; the current system capacity; the cost of conveyance, treatment and disposal per equivalent single-family dwelling unit; and the estimated daily discharge for each facility to be connected to the sanitary sewer system, taking into account proportionate average daily discharge of sewage, total organic carbon, suspended solids, and ammonia nitrogen.

The fees or charges shall be collected from the owner or developer of property either (1) prior to approval of the original connection of the property to the water or sanitary sewer system, or a redevelopment with incremental impact, or (2) in the event the uses being made of the property presently connected to the system are enlarged, added to, or further structures are constructed on the property.
