SUBJECT: Reject Proposal Received In Response to Request for Proposals F0805-71 to Provide Continuing Technical Support for Maximo Computer Maintenance Management System Version 4.1.1

BACKGROUND

Approval is requested to reject a proposal received in response to Request for Proposals F0805-71 to provide continuing technical support for the Computer Maintenance Management System (CMMS) Maximo version 4.1.1 used at the Water Pollution Control Plant (WPCP). Staff issued a Request for Proposal in order to explore third party vendor support.

DISCUSSION

Request for Proposal (RFP) specifications were prepared by Department of Public Works and Department of Information Technology staff, and RFP No. F0805-71 was issued on August 3, 2009. The RFP document included evaluation criteria worth a total of 300 points, including overall maintenance and support capability, implementation, professional capabilities, references and cost. Proposals were direct mailed to known suppliers of Maximo support and broadcast to other potential proposers through the Demandstar by Onvia public procurement network. The proposal due date was August 19, 2009. One proposal was received from InterlocSolutions, Inc. of Folsom.

Staff recommends rejection of the proposal because it did not fully address all of the services required in the RFP. Staff will explore options and revise the specifications and reissue the RFP, if appropriate.
