SUBJECT: Request by Staff for Continuation to November 24, 2009

Sunnyvale Municipal Code Chapters 18.10 and 19.74 Relating to Park Dedication: Consider Raising the Park Facility Standard from 1.25 Acres per 1,000 Population to 3.0 Acres per 1,000 Population

REPORT IN BRIEF

The staff requests a continuance of the amendment of ordinances 18.10 and 19.74 relating to park dedication, which would raise the facility standard from 1.25 acres per 1,000 population to 3.0 acres over three years, from the City Council meeting of October 27, 2009, to the meeting of November 24, 2009, in order to assist with agenda management. The item was heard by the Planning Commission on October 12, 2009, and by the Parks and Recreation Commission on October 14, 2009.
