SPRAY POOLS

Occasionally, residents inquire regarding spray pools in Sunnyvale parks. Following is information for some of the most commonly asked questions about spray pools.

- **Park Locations for spray pools free to the public:**

1. Braly
2. Fair Oaks
3. Ortega
4. Serra
5. Lakewood

- Spray pools are operable from April *through* October, 7 days a week during normal park hours of 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.
- They are turned on by the public manually by either turning a dial or pressing a hand-shaped panel. The control device is located adjacent to each spray pool.
- The Spray Pools use safe potable water.
- **Las Palmas is the only spray pool that can not be turned on by the public.**
- **How to have it turned on:**
- A permit must be obtained at least one (1) week in advance of requested date by calling Recreation Division, Reservations staff at (408) 730-7751.
- The spray pool is available for use 7 days a week from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., during the months of April – October.
- Permits are issued to provide for the cost recovery of staff time to turn water on/off in 2-hour intervals. These permits are not for exclusive use.
- Once the spray pool is turned on by Recreation Division staff, it will be available to the permittee and to the General Public for use!

Fees: \$60.00 for 2-Hour Interval-- All fees are due when permit is issued.

Cancellation Policy:

Fees will be refunded if the Reservation Office is notified five (5) or more working days prior to the permitted date.
