Whatever the event, City of Sunnyvale pools are a great place to come laugh, splash, play or compete with exclusive use of the un-guarded pool for you and your guests. All pools are heated and maintained to between 78° and 82°F. All rentals are on a first-come first-serve basis. So reserve today!

★ 1 Columbia Middle School Pool
730 Morse Avenue

- Open March - October
- 25 yd x 6 lane pool
- Locker Room facilities
- Observation/Seating area
- No rentals before dawn or after dusk

★ 2 Sunnyvale Middle School Pool
1080 Mango Avenue

- Open June - August
- 25 yd x 6 lane pool
- Deck and underwater lighting
- Lane lines
- Starting Blocks (6)
- Diving Board
- Locker Room facilities
- Bleachers with seating for 50

★ 3 Washington Park Pool
255 S. Pastoria Avenue

- Open April - Mid-September
- 33 yd x 6 lane pool
- Diving Board
- Locker Room facilities
- Patio area with seating for 20
- Office/Classroom space
- Pool available between dawn and dusk



How to Make a Reservation

For availability or to book, please call (408) 730-7723. At time of reservation a deposit paid by cash, check or credit card (amount varies based on rental time) in order to secure a reservation. A confirmation email will be sent to the renter with timeline for turning in additional required documents. See back page for details.



Fee Information

Full pool rental is \$75/hour for residents, and \$90/hour for non-residents (Residency is established based on the group's business license address and/or the percentage of Sunnyvale residents served by this group). Minimum of two-hour reservation required.

A \$250 deposit must be placed in order to secure a reservation. Rental groups are charged periodically during the course of the rental, and the payment schedule is based on length and frequency of the rental.

Cancellations for pool rentals must be made at least 72 hours in advance, or the rental group will be charged the full amount for the rental reservation.



Rental Requirements

- Proper insurance coverage, including Commercial General Liability of \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$5,000,000 aggregate for bodily injury, personal injury and property damage, as well as Workers' Compensation statutory limits and Employer's Liability with limits of \$1,000,000 per accident for bodily injury or disease.
- Adequate safety coverage of the pool by licensed aquatic safety staff.
- A first aid kit, AED, rescue tube, backboard, and other aquatic rescue supplies must be available at all times (arrangements can be made with City staff if rental group is unable to provide these items on their own).
- Ability to perform all adequate opening and closing duties as required for the facility.



Pool Rules

- Children age 6 and younger must be directly supervised by a parent/guardian while in the pool. The parent/guardian must accompany the child in the water and remain within arm's length of the child.
- We strongly advise that all parents closely monitor their child's activities in the pool, regardless of the age. This is especially true for beginner swimmers.
- Children who are not toilet trained or who are under the age of 3 must wear approved swim diapers and plastic swim cover beneath their swimsuit.
- Please do not enter the pool if you have an infectious disease, bandage, open blisters or sores.
- Flotation devices, including water wings, padded swimsuits and inner-tubes, are not permitted with the exception of U.S. Coast guard-approved lifejackets.
- With the exception of service dogs, animals are not allowed in the facility.
- Food, drinks, glass, sharp objects and tobacco products are not permitted in the pool area.

Diving Board Rules

- Diving is only allowed in the deep end of the pool.
- One person is allowed on the board at a time.
- One bounce on the board is permitted.
- Jump or dive straight off and swim to the nearest side.

For Your Safety

- Please walk at all times on the pool deck.
- Fighting, roughhousing, chicken fighting, screaming, profanity, holding breath underwater games and pretending to drown are not permitted in the facility.
- Appropriate swim attire is required when entering the pool.
- T-shirts worn over swimsuits and other street clothes may not be worn in the pool.
