Driver's Education (14+)

Driver's Education is a life skill class. There is no substitute for the student-teacher interaction, discussion, video analysis and instant feedback that takes place in the classroom. This course meets the State of California requirement to obtain a driver's instruction permit. The class is 30 hours long and does not include behind-the-wheel instruction. Upon completion of this course student will receive a certificate of completion of classroom driver education. Students must attend all sessions in order to receive the DMV completion certificate. Students must be 15 1/2 to get an instruction permit. A lunch break is provided. Bring a bag lunch.

Leaders in Training Program **NEW**

This innovative two-part program is designed to train and educate teens valuable skills that directly apply to work in the field with youth campers. Teens must first register for training week and are encouraged to sign up for fieldwork at the same time. Note: Teens must graduate from the training week to participate in fieldwork. Specific fieldwork camp assignments will be announced at LIT Training graduation. Teens may earn community service hours while participating in the program. Graduation from program does not guarantee future employment with the City of Sunnyvale.

Leaders in Training (LIT) Week (14 – 18 years)

Training week is designed to teach teens how to become a successful camp leader while earning community service hours. Teens develop leadership skills, enjoy team building activities, learn about behavior management, risk management, supervision and water safety. Week culminates with a formal graduation.
