Choosing the Camp That's Right for Your Child

This will enable families with campers, ages 7 or 11, to choose to register with younger campers or older campers. By doing this, families can select the experience they believe their camper is prepared for. The choice is yours!

- We suggest starting with a traditional camp, designed for specific age groups and offering the most variety of activities.

Need Some Help to Pay for Camp? Apply for Financial Aid

The fee waiver assistance program is available to help qualified Sunnyvale residents offset fees for traditional day camps, sports camps, theatre and art camps, science camps and more.

- For Sunnyvale residents, ages 17 and under
- Family must meet financial eligibility requirements
- Up to \$234 in fees waived per child per fiscal year (July – June)
- Deadline to apply for Summer Camp fee waivers, June 1
- Fee waivers awarded on a first-come, first-served basis until funds run out

Traditional Day Camps – Full Day Option

Back by popular demand, our ultra-spirited, fun-filled camps, Crusade, Quest, Voyager and Pioneer are ready for your camper to spend the summer with us! Sunnyvale's traditional day camps are designed specifically for each age group all at one location. Within each camp, fun and engaging recreational games, activities and field trips are designed for skills and interests. All camps include a weekly walking trip to the Washington Pool (depth is 2.5' to 12'). For additional recreation swim details, visit Swim.inSunnyvale.com. Note: Field trip locations and days are subject to change.

Core Camp Days/Times: M – F, 9 a.m. – 5 p.m.

Extend your camper's day with an extended care option. Drop-off as early as 7:30 a.m. and pick-up as late as 6 p.m.

Camper's need to bring a daily lunch, a water bottle, two snacks (morning and afternoon) and sunscreen. On swim days please bring swim suit, towel and a dry change of clothes. Campers are given one camp t-shirt for the summer. Please wear shirts on highlight activity/trip day. Additional camp shirts can be purchased at camp for \$8.
