Babysitting: American Red Cross


**Babysitting: American Red Cross** (11 – 15 years)

In this 11-hour course, campers learn how to interview for a babysitting job, make responsible decisions, supervise children, and keep kids and themselves safe. Infant basic care will be covered including diapering, holding and feeding as well as basic toddler care. Additional skills taught include rescue breathing and first aid for choking or bleeding. Driver's Education

**Driver's Education** (14+)

Driver's Education is a life skill class. There is no substitute for the student-teacher interaction, discussion, video analysis and instant feedback that takes place in the classroom. This course meets the State of California requirement to obtain a driver's instruction permit. The class is 30 hours long and does not include behind-the-wheel instruction. Upon completion of this course student will receive a certificate of completion of classroom driver education. Students must attend all sessions in order to receive the DMV completion certificate. Students must be 15 1/2 to get an instruction permit. A lunch break is provided. Bring a bag lunch.

**Leaders in Training Program** NEW

The City of Sunnyvale, in partnership with LinkedIn, will provide teens with an innovative two-part program designed to train and educate teens on the valuable skills that are needed to work in the field with youth campers. Teens must first register for Leaders in Training Week and are encouraged to sign up for additional weeks of Leaders in Training Fieldwork at the same time.

Note: Teens must graduate from the training week to participate in fieldwork. Specific fieldwork camp assignments will be announced at LIT Training graduation. Teens may earn community service hours while participating in the program. Graduation from program does not guarantee future employment with the City of Sunnyvale.

**Leaders in Training (LIT) Week** (14 – 18 years)

Training week is designed to teach teens how to become successful camp leaders while earning community service hours. Teens develop leadership skills, enjoy team building activities, learn about behavior management, risk management, supervision and water safety. Later in the week, teens meet with LinkedIn staff to discuss the benefits of a maintaining a positive online image, particularly for college and employment applications. Teens learn, hands on, how to develop and manage an online brand that is unique to them. Week culminates with a formal graduation.

**Leaders in Training (LIT) Fieldwork** (14 – 18 years)
