Back by popular demand, these ultra-spirited, fun-filled traditional camps are designed specifically for each age group. Within each camp, fun and engaging recreational games and activities are designed for a variety of skills and interests.

Most Traditional Camps at one Location

Now drop-off and pick-up is easier for families since Camp Quest, Camp Voyager and Camp Pioneer are at one location, Washington Park.

Core Camp Days/Times: Monday – Friday, 9 a.m. – 5 p.m.

What do the symbols mean?

Field trips occur on one day of the camp week. See individual camp for specific locations. Note: Field trip locations and days are subject to change.

All camps include one recreation swim day at the Washington Pool (depth is 2.5 feet to 12 feet). For additional recreation swim details, visit Swim.inSunnyvale.com.

Extend your camper's day with an extended care option. Drop-off as early as 7:30 a.m. and pick-up as late as 6 p.m.

Campers are given one camp t-shirt for the summer. Wear the t-shirt on highlight activity/trip day. Additional camp shirts can be purchased at camp for \$8.

What to Bring to Camp

Campers need to bring a daily lunch, water bottle, two snacks (morning and afternoon) and sunscreen. On swim day, bring a swimsuit, towel and a dry change of clothes.



Camp Quest

Camp Quest – 7:1 Ratio (5 – 7 years)

Each week includes indoor and outdoor games, fun obstacle courses and lively summertime activities designed around each camper's skill level and interest. Led by friendly, caring, patient, fun and energetic staff, campers enjoy age-appropriate arts and crafts projects, fun fitness activities, story time by camp staff and a weekly visit by librarians from Sunnyvale Public Library. Each week features a new field trip.

The fee waiver assistance program is available to help qualified Sunnyvale residents offset fees for City of Sunnyvale summer camps and more.

- For Sunnyvale residents, ages 17 and under
- Family must meet financial eligibility requirements
- Up to \$234 in fees waived per child per fiscal year (July – June)
- Deadline to apply for Summer Camp fee waivers is June 1
- Awarded on a first-come, first-served basis until funds run out
