Gymnastics

We ask family and friends to remain outside the gym during class times to reduce distractions for our students, except for: 1) at least one parent will be asked to stay and observe any environment with only one staff member, 2) parents of new students may stay during the first class, 3) if a staff member asks a parent to stay. We encourage all parents to observe the last class of each session. Thank you for your cooperation. On average, students take one year to complete a level. We recommend students attend year-round or two days per week to increase the rate of learning.


