## **SPRAY POOLS**

Occasionally, residents inquire regarding spray pools in Sunnyvale parks. Following is information for some of the most commonly asked questions about spray pools.

### **Park Locations for Spray Pools Free to the Public**

1. Braly 704 Daffodil Court, Sunnyvale, 94086
2. Fair Oaks 540 N. Fair Oaks Avenue, Sunnyvale, 94085
3. Ortega 636 Harrow Way, Sunnyvale, 94087
4. Serra 730 the Dalles, Sunnyvale, 94087
5. Lakewood 834 Lakechime Drive, Sunnyvale, 94089

- Spray pools are operable from April through October, 7 days a week during normal park hours of 8 a.m. – 8 p.m.
- Spray pools are turned on by the public manually by either turning a dial or pressing a hand-shaped panel. The control device is located adjacent to each spray pool.
- Spray pools use safe potable water.

**Las Palmas (850 Russet Drive, Sunnyvale, 94087) is the only spray pool that can't be turned on by the public. How to have Las Palmas spray pool turned on:**

- A permit must be obtained at least one (1) week in advance of requested date by calling the Community Services Division, Reservations Staff at (408) 730-7751, Monday through Friday, 9 a.m. – 6 p.m.
- The spray pool is available for use 7 days a week from 10 a.m. – 5 p.m., during the months of April through October.
- Permits are issued to provide for the cost recovery of staff time to turn water on/off in 2-hour intervals. These permits are not for exclusive use.
- Once the spray pool is turned on by Community Services staff, it will be available to the permittee and to the general public for use.
- **Fees for Las Palmas Spray Pool:** \$60.00 for 2-hour interval. All fees are due when permit is issued.
- **Cancellation Policy:** Fees will be refunded if the Reservation Office is notified five (5) or more working days prior to the permitted date. Reservations staff can be reached at (408) 730-7751, Monday through Friday, 9 a.m. – 6 p.m.

### **MAINTENANCE & REPAIRS**

Spray Pools that do not work properly should be reported to the Parks Division at (408) 730-7506.
