Senior Lunch Program Update

On Tuesday, June 28, 2011, City Council adopted the fiscal year 2011/2012 budget, fee schedule and appropriations limit. The budget addresses an existing structural deficit in the City budget by calling for approximately \$2.1 million in expenditure reductions.

Q. What is the status of the Lunch Program at the Senior Center since Council action?

A. In an effort to continue the service, the onsite caterer, Wild Tastes, worked with staff and negotiated terms that will allow the lunch program to carry on at no net cost to the City. This new agreement maintains the lunch program through June 30, 2012.

Q. Will the price of lunches increase?

A. Lunch prices will continue to be \$5.50 for members and \$8.00 for non members.

Q. What will happen to the program after June 30, 2012?

A. Staff will submit a Request for Proposals (RFP) to solicit caterers and businesses interested in operating the Lunch Program for subsequent years. The Senior Lunch Program's continuance will be dependent on the success of this RFP process.
