

### DAY 1: TUESDAY, 2/28

Fly to Orlando, Florida, to begin exploring the Sunshine State. Meet the tour director and transfer to your hotel to begin a three-night stay, which will be kicked off with a **Welcome Dinner** and a briefing about beautiful Florida and exciting Disney World.

Meal: (D) Overnight: Orlando

### DAY 2: WEDNESDAY, 2/29

Explore the imagination of **Walt Disney's EPCOT** (Experimental Prototype Community of Tomorrow), which combines Disney fun and imagination with real world wonders. EPCOT, one of four theme parks located within Disney World, is comprised of two major areas to enjoy: **World Showcase**, where you can relive the wonders of the last century; and **Future World**, where you can preview what the next 100 years might have in store.

Meal: (B) Overnight: Orlando

### DAY 3: THURSDAY, 3/1

Embark on a journey to nearby **Cape Canaveral** and the famed **Kennedy Space Center**. A guided tour will provide insight into NASA and the nation's space program, from inception to its current programs and exploration of, in the words of Captain James T. Kirk, "the Final Frontier." Return early this afternoon and enjoy the rest of the day and evening on your own, by simply enjoying the amenities at the hotel, or perhaps by going back to Disney World and purchasing a ticket to enjoy some of the magic readily available at the other theme parks.

**DAY 4: FRIDAY, 3/2**

**Fort Myers**, established in 1886, is the seat of Lee County and home to two historic homes: **Seminole Lodge** and **The Mangoes**. At Seminole Lodge, the home of Thomas Edison, check out a collection of Edison's inventions and stroll his cherished tropical gardens. Then, you'll have time to visit the adjoining property, The Mangoes, which was purchased by Edison's good friend, Henry Ford, in 1916. Later in the day, arrive at the resort town of **Marco Island**, situated at the northernmost point of the picturesque Ten Thousand Islands, for an overnight stay.

Meals: (B, D) Overnight: Marco Island

**DAY 5: SATURDAY, 3/3**

Adventure through **Everglades National Park**, the largest subtropical wilderness in the United States and a **UNESCO World Heritage Site**, and experience the wildlife, flora and fauna via a—wind in your face—**airboat ride**. Later travel to the scenic and relaxing Florida Keys and arrive in the Key Largo area for a three-night stay.

Meals: (B, D) Overnight: Key Largo



**DAY 6: SUNDAY, 3/4**

Today, visit **Pennekamp National Marine Sanctuary**, referred to as “the Diving Capital of the World.” Enjoy a two-and-a-half-hour cruise aboard the 65-foot, 130 passenger *Spirit of Pennekamp*. This glass-bottom catamaran allows unique glimpses into the serene, undersea world of coral reef wildlife living within the **Florida Keys National Marine Sanctuary**, which encompasses the third largest coral barrier reef in the world. Later, return to your hotel where the remainder of the day is yours to enjoy on your own.

Meals: (B, D) Overnight: Key Largo

**DAY 7: MONDAY, 3/5**

Motor along the **Florida Keys Scenic Highway**, also known as the *Overseas Highway*, to the southernmost point in the Continental U.S. This scenic roadway provides spectacular views of the gentle turquoise waters of the Gulf of Mexico on one side and the majestic Atlantic Ocean on the other. This unique journey through the Keys features over 43 bridges, including *Seven Mile Bridge*, enroute to **Key West**. Enjoy a **Key West Trolley Tour** to visit many famous sights, including: Ernest Hemingway's Home; Fort Zackary; the Audubon House & Gardens; and **Southernmost Point**, located less than 90 miles from Cuba. This afternoon, visit Mallory Square and stroll along Duval Street with its colorful cafes, shops and boutiques. Be sure to sample the Caribbean cuisine and a drink at one of Hemingway's former hangouts.

Meal: (B) Overnight: Key Largo

**DAY 8: TUESDAY, 3/6**

Travel north along the Atlantic seashore to the exciting, international city of **Miami**. Enjoy a panoramic **Miami City Tour** featuring Art Deco South Beach, Little Havana, Coconut Grove and Bricknell Avenue. Also visit the **Villa Vizcaya**, the landmark estate of International Harvester mogul, James Deering. Located on Biscayne Bay, this estate features Italian Renaissance gardens, historic outbuildings and models a Tuscan estate. Tonight, enjoy a **Farewell Dinner** with your travel companions.

**DAY 9: WEDNESDAY, 3/7**

Today finds you homeward bound, leaving from Miami International Airport, with memories of Florida—the Sunshine State.
