**Day 1: Tuesday, May 14**

Today, depart for your flight to Philadelphia. Upon arrival, meet your **Tour Director** and transfer to your hotel for a three-night stay. Enjoy the remainder of the evening at leisure.

**Day 2: Wednesday, May 15**

Today, visit **Valley Forge National Historic Park**. Valley Forge was the winter encampment for the Continental Army in 1777-78. Sites include Washington's Headquarters and the chapel. Later see exquisite flowers, majestic trees, dazzling fountains and more at **Longwood Gardens**. Many generations helped shape Longwood, but the most enduring contribution came from industrialist, conservationist, farmer, designer and philanthropist, Pierre S. duPont. Your visit will include the gardens, fountains and more. Tonight enjoy dinner at **Longwood Gardens** before returning to Philadelphia for the night.

**Day 3: Thursday, May 16**

Today enjoy the magnificence of both the **Winterthur Gardens** as well as the **Nemours Mansion and Gardens** in nearby Wilmington, DE. Winterthur, founded by Henry Francis du Pont is the premier museum of American decorative arts, reflecting both early America and the du Pont's life here. Its 60-acre naturalistic garden is among the country's best. Nemours is the 300-acre country estate of the late industrialist Alfred I. du Pont. Tour the gardens and home of this magnificent estate built in 1907.

**Day 4: Friday, May 17**

This morning experience the **Barnes Foundation**. The mission of the foundation is "the

promotion of the advancement of education and the appreciation of the fine arts." This is a wonderful collection of some incredible works of art. Later cross into New Jersey to make a stop at **Wheaton Arts Glass Museum**. Visit and see the Museum of American Glass, founded in the 1960's by Frank H. Wheaton, Jr. Later continue on to **Cape May, NJ** for an overnight in the quaint seaside resort town renowned for its old Victorian architecture.

**Day 5: Saturday, May 18**

This morning enjoy the ferry ride from New Jersey to Delaware before continuing onto **Annapolis, MD** for a two-night stay. Upon arrival enjoy a **Tour of Annapolis** including the **Maryland State House**, the harbor area and more. Later visit and tour the **United States Naval Academy**.

*Meal - (B) Overnight - Annapolis*

**Day 6: Sunday, May 19**

Today, enjoy a tour of the **Hampton National Historic Site** to learn about the history of the plantation, the enslaved individuals and the story of the economic and moral changes that made this kind of life obsolete. Later you will visit **Fort McHenry**. During the Battle of Baltimore, the star shaped fort inspired Francis Scott Key to write, "The Star Spangled Banner". This evening enjoy **Baltimore's Inner Harbor** and an included **Farewell Dinner** with your fellow travelers.

**CANCELLATION WAIVER & POST DEPARTURE PLAN**
