SOUTHERN ITALY & SICILY

Day 1: Thursday, April 18, 2013

Overnight Flight Join Collette Vacations in exploring the hidden treasures of southern Italy and Sicily. Enjoy breathtaking scenery, historic cities, centuries old hilltop villages and wonderful cuisine.

Day 2: Friday, April 19, 2013

Palermo, Sicily - Tour Begins Your tour begins in Palermo, the capital of Sicily. This evening, join your fellow travelers for a welcome dinner featuring traditional Sicilian cuisine. (D)

Day 3: Saturday, April 20, 2013

Palermo - Monreale - Palermo A Palermo cultural tour features the lovely squares of Quattro Canti, Piazza Pretoria and Piazza Bellini. Note the exotic mixture of Moorish, Norman and Spanish Baroque styles that make this city special. Also see the Palace of the Normans, La Martorana Church, and the Cathedral, which houses the Imperial Crown of Constance of Aragon. **In the nearby town of Monreale, visit the 12th century Cathedral with its dazzling interior of multicolored marbles, paintings, mosaics and cloisters.** Enjoy the rest of your day at leisure to visit some of the city's great museums and shops. (B)

Day 4: Sunday, April 21, 2013

Palermo - Agrigento After a short lesson on the local language, travel through the beautiful countryside with rolling hills and working farms towards the town of Agrigento. Upon arrival, visit the stunning Valley of the Temples, one of the most important archeological sites in the world and a UNESCO World Heritage site. From ancient times to the present day, the Valley of the Temples' ruins, landscape and colors have inspired poets, writers and painters. Here you get an up-close view of the temples of Juno, Concordia, Hercules and Jupiter. (B, D)

Day 5: Monday, April 22, 2013

Agrigento - Catania - Mt. Etna - Giardini Naxos Depart Agrigento and travel across Sicily, with its spectacular landscapes and picturesque towns. Arrive in vibrant Catania where a local guide will share its history. Visit the cathedral and view the main sites of this historic and baroque city. Witness the daily spectacle of bartering for fresh fish and produce when you visit the local market. **Later, visit Mt. Etna Volcano National Park to see the spectacular landscapes sculpted by nature.** Arrive in Giardini Naxos, the "garden of Sicily." (B, D)

Day 6: Tuesday, April 23, 2013

Giardini Naxos - Taormina - Giardini Naxos This morning you visit beautiful Taormina, known for its charming atmosphere, significant monuments and flowering gardens. Enjoy viewing the Greek Amphitheater, Corso Umberto and the bountiful Public Gardens. Enjoy the rest of the day at leisure to further explore this delightful town. (B)

Day 7: Wednesday, April 24, 2013

Giardini Naxos - Basilicata Travel to Messina where you will take a short ferry ride to Villa San Giovanni on Italy's mainland. Travel through the beautiful and unspoiled region of Calabria and into the Basilicata region, arriving this afternoon in the seaside town of Scanzano Jonico. Late afternoon you'll visit one of the area's local wineries for a wine tasting and informative visit through the cellars and vineyards. Linger over a

delicious regional dinner in the winery's own "agriturismo" restaurant. (B, D)

Day 8: Thursday, April 25, 2013

Basilicata - Taranto - Alberobello - Basilicata Today, venture into the region of Apulia. Begin your day with a drive towards Taranto, one of Italy's most important port cities. Your visit to this southern town will include a special tour of the Aragonese Castle, dating back to the 15th century and belonging today to the Italian Marines. Then it's off to the mystical town of Alberobello where you will see some of the most unusually built homes, known as "trulli," with cone-shaped roofs and no mortar to hold the stones together. Return to Basilicata for a special Italian evening! Tonight's dinner will include a pasta-making demonstration and an extensive dinner with all the local favorites and an entertaining performance of traditional music. (B, D)

Day 9: Friday, April 26, 2013

Basilicata - Matera - Sorrento Peninsula Travel towards Campania and the Bay of Naples, one of the most breathtaking areas of Italy. Visit a local cheese producer to learn the secrets of making mozzarella and ricotta cheeses. Then stop at the "Sassi di Matera," an ancient town known for its cave dwellings, both modern and ancient. A local guide will help you learn the history of this site and why it has recently caught the eye of many film producers. Arrive at the Sorrento Peninsula in the late afternoon and take in the views of this magical place. (B, D)

Day 10: Saturday, April 27, 2013

Sorrento - Amalfi Coast Drive - Sorrento Peninsula Begin your day exploring the popular seaside resort town of Sorrento. Visit local artisans and watch them demonstrate the art of inlaid wood making. This afternoon take time to explore this lovely town on your own. Then begin your adventure exploring the breathtaking Amalfi Coast. Make a special stop in the charming town of Amalfi where you will have time to explore. Then it's off to Minori where you will have the opportunity to sample some of the local specialties at a family-owned limoncello factory. You'll also enjoy a typical Italian afternoon break at a local café and pastry shop. Your evening is at leisure to enjoy Sorrento's chic restaurants or outdoor cafes. (B)

Day 11: Sunday, April 28, 2013

Sorrento Peninsula - Pompeii - Rome Travel along the Bay of Naples and experience the excavated ruins of Pompeii at the foothills of Mount Vesuvius. Soak in the history of the preserved original buildings of a typical Roman town 2,000 years ago. A local guide will provide an in-depth view of this remarkable archeological sight. Later, travel to Rome where you will spend your last evening. Tonight, celebrate the end of your journey with a farewell dinner at a popular local restaurant. (B, D)

Day 12: Monday, April 29, 2013

Rome - Tour Ends Your tour ends today, leaving you with many pleasant memories of a wonderful vacation. (B)

Day 12: Malpensa - St. Julian's, Malta - St. Julian's

Fly from Malpensa to the mythic isle of Malta. A charming adventure awaits as you explore the narrow meandering streets of the archipelago's delightful towns and villages. Often described as an open-air museum, Malta is also packed with historical highlights. Renaissance cathedrals and Baroque palaces give way to a countryside dotted with some of the world's oldest known human structures. Look out over the Mediterranean Sea and take some time to get acquainted with your beautiful hotel in the town of St. Julian's.

Day 13: St. Julian's - Valletta - Mdina - St. Julian's

This morning it's off to Valletta, Malta's present day capital and a UNESCO World Heritage site. A locally guided tour showcases the Barraca gardens, affording beautiful views of Malta's Grand Harbor and the city of Birgu (Citta` Vittoriosa) in the distance. You will also visit the Co-Cathedral of St. John, one of the most impressive examples of High Baroque architecture in the Mediterranean. Learn about the Knights of St. John and the importance of Malta's historically strategic position. The island rests just 58 miles south of Sicily and 179 miles north of Africa. This evening, embark on a short scenic trip to nearby Mdina, Malta's original capital city. A local guide leads the way on a magical evening tour as you explore the medieval streets and the impressive bastions along the city walls, all beautifully lit up at night. Afterwards, savor a special dinner in one of the city's enchanting restaurants. Indulge in some local specialties and the island's fines wines. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

Day 14: St. Julian's

Today it's your choice! Enjoy some time by the pool, take a stroll along St. Julian's vibrant seaside promenade or do some more sightseeing in this island paradise. You may wish to sign up for an optional full-day excursion to the nearby island of Gozo, Malta's 2nd largest island with history dating back to 5000 BC. On your last evening in Malta, travel to nearby Birgu for a special farewell dinner overlooking the Grand Harbor. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

Day 15: St. Julian's, Malta - Rome, Italy

This morning, flight permitting, you may enjoy time to do some last minute shopping or take in the breathtaking sea views. Bid farewell to Malta. After your flight, you will overnight near Rome's Fiumicino airport. *Today breakfast will be included.*
