


ITINERARY

Day 1 - FLY TO SALT LAKE CITY

Transfer from Sunnyvale to the San Francisco Airport for your flight to Salt Lake City.

Welcome to Salt Lake City! You will be met and transferred to your hotel. Time to relax or take a walk around the hotel grounds. At 6 p.m., gather at the hotel with your Travel Director and fellow travelers for a Welcome Reception.

Meal(s): (Welcome Reception) Hotel: Sheraton Salt Lake City

Day 2-SALT LAKE CITY - JACKSON (2 NIGHTS)

Traveling north into Idaho, trace the footsteps of the pioneers at the Oregon Trail Center in Montpelier. Through interactive exhibits, you'll travel vicariously with a covered wagon train in America's great western migration and experience the thrills and challenges of the old Oregon Trail. Then cross into Wyoming on your way to scenic Jackson, which stands in the shadows of the icy peaks of the Grand Tetons. Get spectacular 360-degree views of the Snake River Valley and Grand Teton National Park on an exciting aerial tram ride to the summit of Rendezvous Mountain.

Meal(s): (Full Breakfast / Lunch) Hotel: The Lodge at Jackson Hole

Day 3-GRAND TETON NATIONAL PARK

If you like, hit the water this morning on an optional guided float trip down the Snake River where you'll float with grand views of the magnificent Grand Tetons. Keep your eyes open for some of the area's abundant wildlife, including moose and elk drinking from the rivers, bison munching on grass, and beavers putting the finishing touches on their elaborate dams. Enjoy some free time in Jackson this afternoon before joining your Travel Director and travel companions for a Highlight Dinner - Chuckwagon Roundup Meal

Meal(s): (Full Breakfast / Highlight Dinner) Hotel: The Lodge at Jackson Hole

Day 4-JACKSON - YELLOWSTONE NATIONAL PARK (2 NIGHTS)

Spend the day discovering the natural glories of Grand Teton National Park with its snow-capped mountains, pristine alpine lakes and evergreen forests. From Jenny Lake to the jagged peaks of the Teton Range, you'll find exhilarating vistas everywhere you look. Then it's onward to Yellowstone, established in 1872 as the world's first National Park. You could spend a year in Yellowstone and still only scratch the surface of its wonders. Watch in wonder as Old Faithful's waters arc nearly 40 metres (130 feet) into the air—as it has done approximately every hour since the Washburn Expedition discovered it in 1870. Take a guided walk with a local expert among the spouting geysers, bubbling mudpots and turquoise hot springs. Tonight, dine in the park; before retiring for the night, be sure to step out and take in the grand panorama of stars.

Meal(s): (Full Breakfast / Dinner) Hotel: National Park Lodges

Day 5-YELLOWSTONE NATIONAL PARK SIGHTSEEING

Begin the day by looking for wildlife in Hayden Valley en route to the impressive Grand Canyon of Yellowstone with its stunning waterfalls. Continue on the upper loop to Dunraven Pass and the Lamar Valley, some of the less traveled, but ruggedly beautiful regions of the park. At Mammoth Hot Springs, take a stroll and admire the mineral terraces that resemble frozen waterfalls cascading down into the valley.

Meal(s): (Full Breakfast) Hotel: National Park Lodges

Day 6-YELLOWSTONE NATIONAL PARK - CODY - SHERIDAN

Head east to the town of Cody and get a glimpse into the fascinating history of the American West at the Buffalo Bill Historical Center. There you can delve into the culture of the cowboy, the role of the firearm in the opening of the West and the culture and art of the Plains Indians.

This evening, enjoy a Be My Guest dinner in true Western style at a historic cafe, complete with an old time tobacco shop. It will be an evening you won't soon forget!

Meal(s): (Full Breakfast / Be My Guest Dinner) Hotel: Sheridan Holiday Inn

Day 7-SHERIDAN - DEADWOOD - RAPID CITY (2 NIGHTS)

Proclaimed by Theodore Roosevelt as America's first national monument, the majestic Devil's Tower rises nearly 396 metres (1,300 feet) above the Belle Fourche River in eastern Wyoming. You might recognize the iconic monolith from the climactic scenes of the movie "Close Encounters of the Third Kind." After exploring the area around the eroded core of this ancient volcano, head into the Black Hills of South Dakota and the boomtown of Deadwood, which arose after the discovery of gold in the 1870s. Explore the town on a private trolley tour and learn a bit about its founding, expansion and decline from your entertaining guide. Journey on to Rapid City for a two night stay. Tonight you will have the option of visiting Mt. Rushmore to see the magical illumination ceremony. **Meal(s): (Full Breakfast) Hotel: Adoba Eco Hotel and Suites**

Day 8-BLACK HILLS EXCURSION & FREE TIME

This morning discover more of the natural and man-made wonders of the Black Hills with a drive through stunning scenery on your way to see the Crazy Horse Memorial, a massive mountain carving of the famed war chief of the Oglala people. Next is a visit to Mount Rushmore, designed by sculptor Gutzon Borglum to celebrate the "founding, expansion, preservation and unification of the United States" through enormous carvings of George Washington, Thomas Jefferson, Theodore Roosevelt and Abraham Lincoln. This afternoon, you may want to take the optional Bear Country tour into the Badlands of South Dakota. This evening, raise a glass of wine to your Travel Director and fellow travel companions at a festive Farewell Dinner. **Meal(s): (Full Breakfast / Farewell Dinner) Hotel: Adoba Eco Hotel and Suites**

Day 9-DEPART RAPID CITY

Bid farewell to your travelling companions and transfer to Rapid City Airport for your return flight. Shuttle from the airport to Sunnyside ending a most memorable trip seeing the wonders of America's National Parks. **Meal(s): (Full Breakfast)**

Sightseeing Highlights

Montpelier - Learn about the journey of the West's early pioneers at the Oregon Trail Center.

Jackson - Duck under the elk-horn arches and stroll the boardwalks in this authentic Old-West town; take an aerial tram to the summit of Rendezvous Mountain for spectacular views of Grand Teton National Park.

Grand Teton National Park - View soaring peaks and abundant wildlife.

Yellowstone National Park - Look out for Old Faithful as well as bison, elk and bears while exploring America's first National Park.

Cody - Learn about the Old West at the Buffalo Bill Historical Center.

Devil's Tower National Monument - Explore the stunning landscape around this iconic natural formation.

Deadwood - Tour this National Historic Landmark by private trolley.

Black Hills - Visit Mount Rushmore and the Crazy Horse Memorial.
