CHINA CAMP AND MARIN CIVIC CENTER WITH GARY

Thursday, July 11, 2013



Our first stop of the day will be near San Rafael for a docent-led tour of China Camp State Park on the shore of San Pablo Bay. With its beautiful views of the waterfront, this historic Chinese shrimp-fishing village from the 1880s has a couple of original buildings left and a small museum, but still tells a fascinating, but little known tale. Then it's off for lunch at Chalet Basque where your meal will start with a spring mix salad with house-made vinaigrette.

Then you'll have your choice of entrees – **A) Grilled Chicken Breast** with mushroom sauce and French fries, **B) Poached Salmon Picatta** with rice, or **C) 8-ounce Grilled New York Steak** with peppercorn sauce and rice. All meals also include mixed vegetables, bread and butter, choice of soda, coffee, hot or iced tea, and chocolate mousse for dessert. After lunch we continue on to the Marin Civic Center for a docent-led tour of Frank Lloyd Wright's last commission. This National Historic Landmark was the largest of Wright's public projects. Gary Holloway, our step-on guide, will entertain you with tales gathered over a lifetime of living in the Bay Area.

COFFEE TASTING AND A BITE OF CHEESE

Friday, July 26, 2013

We love our coffee, but how much do you know about what goes into producing your favorite brews? On this trip to Barefoot Coffee in San Jose, you'll learn about the different kinds of beans, how the soil and growing conditions influence their flavor and how the roasting process is tailored to produce the best experience for various brewing styles. You'll also sample several brews and have the opportunity to buy their freshly roasted coffees at a discount. Then it's off to lunch at Los Gatos Brewing Company where your choices will be: **A) Tunisian Chickpea Stew** with butternut squash, quinoa, currants, and pinenuts; **B) Flat Iron Steak** with seasonal vegetables and mashed potatoes; or **C) Breast of Chicken** with seasonal vegetables and mashed potatoes. All meals also include a market salad, choice of coffee, tea, or soda, and chocolate mousse cake for dessert. After lunch, we'll walk around the corner to the San Pedro Square Marketplace for a brief talk about cheese and a mini-tasting at the Little Cheese Shoppe. You'll have some time to purchase cheeses to take home – at a discount – or shop the rest of the Marketplace.

NIKE MISSILE SITE, LUNCH AT SPINNAKERS AND SAUSALITO WITH GARY

Wednesday, August 7, 2013

Now decommissioned, the Nike missile site in San Rafael once had the distinction of being the only active nuclear launch site that was simultaneously a museum. On our way to the Nike missile site for our ranger-led tour, we'll pick up Gary Holloway and enjoy a brief visit to the Marin Headlands Visitors Center. On this tour of the only restored Nike missile site in the entire country, you can take the stairs down into the underground storage area and get a close-up look at the tools of the Cold War. Then it's off to lunch at Spinnakers with its fabulous views where your lunch options will be: **A) Angel Hair Pasta** with rock shrimp, bay scallops, and manila clams; **B) Spinnaker Hamburger**, with choice of cheese, hickory smoked bacon, and french fries; **C) Piquant Chicken Breasts Saute**, with champagne, lemon and capers; or **D) Crab Cakes**, dungeness and rock crab with fresh tropical fruit salsa. All meals include a green salad, choice of coffee, tea or iced tea and bread pudding for dessert. Afterwards, you'll have some free time in Sausalito to walk, shop, or just enjoy the ambiance of this delightful community.

SAN FRANCISCO HISTORY AND LUNCH AT PIER 39

Wednesday, August 21, 2013

Our day starts with a visit to the recently opened San Francisco History Museum. With 22 themed rooms featuring topics like the Gold Rush, the 1906 Earthquake and Alcatraz, along with lighter fare like the Hippie Generation, Bay Area Legends and Stars with a SF connection, this new museum uses memorabilia and short videos to capture the wide range of things that make this area so special. Then it's off to lunch at the Fog Harbor Fish House on Pier 39. Your entrée choices are: **A) Grilled Salmon and Shrimp**, with a Citrus Buerre Blanc; **B) Grilled New York Steak**, with a Mushroom Demi-Glace; or **C) Dungeness Crab Cakes**, with Cajun Remoulade. All meals come with garlic mashed potatoes and seasonal vegetables, start with a house-made New England clam chowder, and end with cheesecake and your choice of hot tea or coffee. You'll have your choice of whether to stay with Gary for the whole 3+ hours we'll be there or take off through the trees to find works by some of your favorite artists. Before heading home, we'll have a late lunch at Il Fornaio in Palo Alto. Your entrée choices will be: **A) Insalata di Pollo Dal Girarosto**, *mixed greens, shredded free-range rotisserie chicken, applewood smoked bacon, shaved Grana Padano cheese, tomatoes, garlic croutons with house vinaigrette*; **B) Fettucine alla Bolognese**, *fresh egg pasta, traditional meat ragu, Parmesan cheese*; **C) Conchiglie al Pollo**,

shell pasta, chicken breast, broccoli, sun-dried tomatoes, Pecorino cheese, roasted garlic; and **D) Paccheri alle Melanzane**, *pasta tubes tossed with diced eggplant, tomatoes, and smoked mozzarella*. Highlights of this trip include: the Air Museum; an Art Museum; Shield's Date Garden and Gift Shops, including date milkshakes, an educational video on the unique growing process of dates, and lots of yummy samples; plus the Living Desert, a collection of animals and plants indigenous to the area. We'll have a City tour including viewing stars' homes; go to a matinee of the Palm Springs Follies, and then browse the Villagefest Street Fair, with sidewalk performers, musicians, a farmer's market, gifts and lots of food.

The price for this four-day trip is \$1,354(R) pp double occupancy and \$1,628(R) single occupancy. Deposit is \$200 pp, with balance due Wednesday, January 22, 2014. Trip includes four meals (three breakfasts and one dinner) and three nights at the Hilton Spa Hotel or similar accommodations.

Start your adventure with an evening in Istanbul on your own, followed by two days of comprehensive tours of this city and its Roman, Byzantine and Ottoman monuments. Then, motorcoach through the Bulgarian countryside to Plovdiv for a city tour, to Veliko Tarnovo for a tour and lunch in Arbanasi and to Rousse where we'll embark on our seven-day cruise on the Danube,

After that date there could likely be only expensive cabins left.

The price for this 13-day trip depends on the cabin you choose—please pick up the trip flyer for more details. Deposit is \$1300pp, with balance due Thursday, April 24, 2014. Trip includes all meals onboard the cruise ship (three breakfasts, one lunch and one dinner on the land portion).

Trip Policies & Procedures

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Day Trips: Arrive 30 minutes before departure time to check in and board the bus. All participants must depart/return with the group on the bus. If you do not arrive by the departure time, you MAY NOT join the group while the trip is in progress.
- Slide show previews of extended trips - see page 5. You can now register for all trips upon receipt of this newsletter.
- **Registration for extended trips can be completed at the front desk before the June 4, 2013, slide show.**
- The Sunnyvale Senior Center reserves the right to make necessary changes or modifications to a trip, including menu choices.

Day trips will list the cost of the trip for both Sunnyvale Residents (R) and Non-residents (NR).

For extended trips, non-residents will be charged an additional \$50 per trip.

CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS

DAY TRIPS

- Those canceling any day trip will receive a refund, less a \$10 administrative fee, charged by the City of Sunnyvale if:
 - 1) cancellation is received prior to the day of the trip, **AND**
 - 2) your place is filled from the wait list (if one exists).

NOTE: NO refund if your space is not filled by another participant.

- No-shows will NOT receive a refund.
- Full refunds are made if the trip is canceled by the Senior Center.

EXTENDED TRIPS

- Some deposits are not refundable. Please read the individual trip payment and cancellation policies that apply to the trip you have selected.
- Please be sure to read all trip cancellation and refund policies so you are aware of the penalties involved should you need to cancel your trip.
- There will be no refunds for any unused portion of a tour, unless covered by trip cancellation insurance.
- A cancellation letter is required to cancel a trip.

YOUR HEALTH & SAFETY

IMPORTANT - Members must notify the Senior Center of any changes to their Membership Form. Non-member trip participants must fill out a Trip Emergency/Medical Information Form. This information will be released to medical personnel should an emergency arise.

- Travelers needing special assistance must notify the Senior Center at the time you register to determine what assistance may be reasonably accommodated.
- Trip participants **must be able to independently participate** on trips (take care of personal needs, follow instructions, etc.) or have a caregiver with them to provide personal assistance during a trip. Escorts and bus drivers **CANNOT** be held responsible for lifting or assisting individuals with walking, boarding or deboarding the bus, or personal needs.
- Check with your physician on the advisability of traveling. There may be elements of an extended trip that may not be suitable for certain health conditions, such as high altitude.
- Bring your Medi-Care, Medi-Cal, or other insurance cards with you on a trip.
- If you use a walker or wheelchair or have other special needs, include this information on your Membership Form; non-members should include this information on your Trip Emergency / Medical Information Form. We will make all reasonable accommodations for you.
- Any accident/incident should be reported to a trip escort.
- Trip participants are required to carry PHOTO IDENTIFICATION on all trips for safety and security purposes.

 = trip includes some stairs and/or multiple times on/off bus

 = trip includes hilly terrain



PARKING

Cars are to be parked in the back parking lot at the end opposite the Sunnyvale Historical Museum for day and extended trips. This enables those attending Senior Center classes, lunch program and senior clubs to use the parking spaces in front of the Senior Center, and those visiting the Sunnyvale Historical Museum to park near the museum. The bus will drop participants off at this same location when returning from trips.



Register Now! You can walk in, call or mail in your registration forms for all trips as soon as you receive this newsletter.

Day trips: Use the reservation form in the newsletter for day trips only. You can sign up two people on each form, if they live at the same address.

Service fees will be charged for companions who are 21 - 49 years old. The additional fees are: \$5 for each day trip and \$25 for each extended trip.

PAYMENT INFORMATION

- Prices are based on a per person basis and payment is due at the time of registration.
- Trips may be paid by cash, check, or credit card (Mastercard or VISA).
- For extended trips a \$50 pp non-resident fee is due at time of final payment made out to the City of Sunnyvale.
- Make checks out to the **City of Sunnyvale** unless otherwise noted. A fee of \$30 is charged for any returned check.

REMINDERS

You don't have to be a member of the Sunnyvale Senior Center to go on a trip, although it's encouraged and recommended. However, you must be at least 50 years of age, unless you are accompanying a senior traveler.
