## MARINE MAMMAL CENTER

*Monday, March 26, 2012*

The Marine Mammal Center in Sausalito, CA, recognizes human interdependence with marine mammals and their importance as sentinels of the ocean environment.

They work to foster marine mammal survival and the conservation of their habitat. They never know exactly what animals will be in need at any particular time, but March usually brings baby harbor seals and baby elephant seals, as well as sea lions of all ages to their doors. You'll get a one-hour docent led tour, which requires some walking and lots of standing as they have few places to sit and rest. We can't guarantee this, but we might get to see the staff feed their wild charges. You'll also have some free time to revisit some areas you are especially interested in or go to the gift shop before heading home. But your day begins with an early lunch at Spinnaker's.

The only thing better than the food will be the ocean views. You'll have your choice of: **A) Spinnaker Paella**, with scallops, prawns, mussels, clams, swordfish, Andouille sausage and saffron risotto; **B) Bouillabaisse**, with prawns, scallops, clams, mussels, and fresh fish in a rich broth, and garlic bread; or **C) Chicken Breasts Saute with Mushrooms**, portobello, shiitake, crimini and porcini mushrooms in a velouté cream sauce. ## GREAT LAKES ADVENTURE

*Wed., May 2 – Fri., May 11, 2012*

Fly to Detroit and begin the adventure by stepping back in time to **Greenfield Village**, **Henry Ford's living history museum**, and **workshops of the Wright Brothers, Thomas Edison, Robert Frost and Henry Ford**. Experience a tour and dining at the **Edsel and Eleanor Ford Mansion**, a bit of Bavaria in **Frankenmuth**, Michigan and a bit of Holland at the **Tulip Festival & Dutch Village** at Veldeer Tulip Garden. Visit **President Gerald Ford's Museum & Library** in Grand Rapids, and take a carriage ride on **Mackinac Island**. Travel to **Green Bay** and Door County, the "**Cape Cod of the Midwest**." In Spring Green, tour the famous mansions and architectural wonders of **Frank Lloyd Wright's "Taliesin,"** and **Alex Jordan's "House on a Rock."** We fly home from Chicago's Midway airport.

## SPECTACULAR SOUTH AFRICA

*Thurs., August 23 – Tues., September 4, 2012*

Join us on a most amazing adventure as we travel to the Republic of South Africa. Highlights of the journey include: **Johannesburg** with a guided tour where we'll learn the history of Soweto; a full day open air vehicle safari game drive in **Kruger National Park**, the largest game reserve in South Africa—in search of the big five—elephants, buffalos, lions, leopards and rhinos, while also looking for impala, zebras and giraffes; a flight to **Port Elizabeth**, a beautiful coastal town; a journey to **Tsitsikamma Forest**, home to hundreds of species of birdlife; visits to Knysna, the heart of the Garden Route, and **Featherbed Nature Reserve**, the premier eco-experience on the Garden Route including a drive deep into the forest. We also: travel to **Oudtshoorn** for a guided tour of an ostrich farm; visit a local wine farm in **Sellenbosch**; enjoy **Cape Town** and a panoramic tour of the beautiful harbor, with a cable car ride atop **Table Mountain**; see the Malay Quarter's mosques and minarets; stop at the **Milnerton Lighthouse**; explore the coastal scenery and charming towns that populate the Cape Peninsula; visit the **penguins at Boulder Beach**; explore **Kirstenboach Botanical Gardens**, tour the **African Gold Museum**; and enjoy a traditional African dinner.

## PARKS & SHAKESPEARE

*Mon., September 17 – Sat., September 22, 2012*

This is a fun trip we had totally customized for us. We depart the Senior Center on a motorcoach and head to **Mount Lassen** for a stop at the visitor's center and a chance to see and learn a little about this area. Then we're off to beautiful **Burney Falls** with time to take pictures and a stop at the visitor's center before we drive up to the **Mount Shasta** area. On day two we'll enjoy a four hour tour of Mt. Shasta with a local guide and author of books on Shasta. Afterwards we head to **Ashland** for an evening performance at the **Shakespeare Festival**. On day three we travel to **Crater Lake National Park** for a stop at the visitor's center for a guided tour of the lake area. We'll lunch on our own at Crater Lake Lodge

before we head back to Ashland. On day four we have time to shop and browse Ashland before attending a matinee play, after which we depart for **Gold Beach**. On day five we take a six hour round trip **Mail Boat Ride on the Rogue River** that includes narration, possible wild life sightings and lunch. We overnight in Eureka to begin our journey home. On day six we'll drive through **Ferndale**, noted for its Victorian homes, travel through **beautiful scenic redwoods**, and make a few scenic stops as available as we travel to Sunnyvale.

- Day Trips: Arrive 30 minutes before departure time to check in and board the bus. All participants must depart/return with the group on the bus. If you do not arrive by the departure time, you **MAY NOT** join the group while the trip is in progress.
- **Registration for most extended trips can be completed at the front desk before November 30, 2011.**
- The Sunnyvale Senior Center reserves the right to make necessary changes or modifications to a trip, including menu choices.

## CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS

### DAY TRIPS

- Those canceling any day trip will receive a refund, less a \$10 administrative fee, charged by the City of Sunnyvale if:

  - 2) your place is filled from the wait list (if one exists).

**NOTE: NO refund if your space is not filled by another participant.**

- No-shows will NOT receive a refund.
- Full refunds are made if the trip is canceled by the Senior Center.

- Some deposits are not refundable. Please read the individual trip payment and cancellation policies that apply to the trip you have selected.
- Please be sure to read all trip cancellation and refund policies so you are aware of the penalties involved should you need to cancel your trip.
- There will be no refunds for any unused portion of a tour, unless covered by trip cancellation insurance.
- A cancellation letter is required to cancel a trip.

## YOUR HEALTH & SAFETY

- Bring your Medi-Care, Medi-Cal, or other insurance cards with you on a trip.
- If you use a walker or wheelchair or have other special needs, include this information on your Membership Form; non-members should include this information on your Trip Emergency / Medical Information Form. We will make all reasonable accommodations for you.
- Any accident/incident should be reported to a trip escort.
- Trip participants are required to carry PHOTO IDENTIFICATION on all trips for safety and security purposes.

## PARKING



## Registration, Payment Information and Policies

### REGISTRATION INFORMATION!

- You can mail in your registration form early! They will be processed in order of date received after walk-in registration (unless trip suggests early sign up).
- “Walk-in” registration will be held on Wednesday, 11/30/11: **9 – 10 a.m.**, Orchard Pavilion for day trips; **10 a.m. – Noon**, Laurel Room for extended trips. Numbers will be distributed on a first-come, first-served basis starting at 8:30 a.m.
- After “walk-in” registration is completed, all trips will then be available for purchase at the front desk.
- Service fees will be charged for companions who are 21 - 49 years old. The additional fees are: \$5 for each day trip and \$25 for each extended trip.
- You may register up to two people on registration day, Wednesday, 11/30/11.

### PAYMENT INFORMATION

- Prices are based on a per person basis and payment is due at the time of registration.
- Trips may be paid by cash, check, or credit card (Mastercard or VISA).
- Make checks out to the **City of Sunnyvale** unless otherwise noted. A fee of \$30 is charged for any returned check.
