The City of Sunnyvale Teen Advisory Committee is a 15-member committee comprised of Sunnyvale youth. The TAC has representatives from various middle and high schools. We are responsible for collaborating with the City of Sunnyvale's TAC liaison to develop programs that will enhance the lives of teens, as well as link teens with the community.

TAC programs and initiatives may relate to recreation, self-help, sports, special interests, community involvement and environmental concerns.
