We'll stop on the way for lunch and a stretch, then tour the historic Santa Inez Mission, with time to saunter through the delightful town of Solvang, known for pastries, exquisite imported gifts, and boutique shops. Enjoy a welcome dinner and get to know your fellow travelers before settling into your accommodations in Solvang. Meals: D

**Day 2: Tuesday, March 17** — Driving south, we arrive in San Diego, and will be treated to a narrated Harbor Cruise of San Diego Bay. This is a perfect introduction to America's Finest City, as you see the sights including the patriotic Midway Aircraft Carrier Museum, the Star of India wooden ship, Navy ships in port and the "toolbox skyline." Then we're back on the coach for a highlights tour of the bayside area before checking into the Embassy Suites Hotel. **Day 5: Friday, March 20** — Leaving this friendly city, we head north for the ferry to fabulous Catalina Island. Stroll gorgeous beaches, see the famous Avalon Ballroom, ride on a glass bottom boat, rent a sail boat or just relax for the day on this picturesque island. Then we catch the ferry to Long Beach to settle into your berth on the famous Queen Mary. Meals: B
