

Day 1: Tuesday, May 19

Day 2: Wednesday, May 20

Feel the heartbeat of this vibrant city as we spend today enjoying its major points of interest and attractions. In addition to a 2 1/2 hour cruise of the Ballard Locks, you will have time at Pioneer Square, the Seattle Center with the Space Needle and the Klondike Gold Rush National Park. Day 3: Thursday, May 21

You will surely be impressed at the Boeing Factory in the world's largest building (by volume) as the Future of Flight Tour presents a close up view of the 747-787 production lines, where skilled workers build these colossal airliners. Moving our focus from the air to the waters of the world, we then visit the Seattle Aquarium. See the giant Pacific Octopus, moon jellies or relish the 360 degree view into their undersea dome. B

Day 4: Friday, May 22

This morning's adventure will include an option to see either the unique Underground Tour of Seattle or visit Chihuly Garden and Glass. During the Underground Tour you will roam the subterranean passages that were once the main streets of the old downtown and be entertained with the humorous legends of colorful characters of days past. The Chihuly Garden and Glass will feature many of Chihuly's most popular series of works and architectural installations highlighting the wide-ranging breadth and scope of Dale's career to include new, existing and archival works by the artists. This afternoon we will visit the Northwest Folklife Festival, a celebration of musical and artistic traditions that is now the nation's largest free community arts festival. B

Day 5: Saturday, May 23

Today we have more time to wander through and enjoy the offerings of the Folklife Festival at a leisurely pace. You can browse, shop, listen to the music, watch the shows, see the exhibits, splurge on your favorite foods or just get a good dose of people watching. Then it's back to the airport for your flight home, as you say good bye to all your new friends. B
