Day 1 -2- Saturday, Sunday, September 9-10 - OVERNIGHT FLIGHT TO ZURICH

Transfer from Sunnyvale to the San Francisco Airport for your overnight flight to Zurich. Welcome to Zurich. Be met and transferred to your hotel . After check-in, your Travel Director takes you on an orientation of Switzerland's financial capital before you enjoy a Welcome Reception with your fellow travellers and Travel Director at a local restaurant. **Meal(s) Welcome Reception, Hotel Radisson Blu Airport**

Day 3- Monday, September 11 - ZURICH – LIECHTENSTEIN – SALZBURG SIGHTSEEING

A scenic drive along Lake Zurich brings you to Liechtenstein where you stop at its capital Vaduz. Follow the Arlberg route into the Tyrol, past the pretty skiing area around St. Johann and the Wilder Kaiser Mountains to Salzburg. This impressive city is dominated by Fortress Hohensalzburg. Day 4- Tuesday, September 12 - SALZBURG – VIENNA (2 NIGHTS)


Day 7- Friday, September 15 - VILLACH – CORTINA D'AMPEZZO – INNSBRUCK

The Alpine scenery is breathtaking as you drive into Italy via Carbonin and Lake Misurina to the Tre Croci Pass. Explore Cortina d'Ampezzo, the Olympic skiing resort set in the heart of the Dolomites. Traverse spectacular mountain passes as you cross back into Austria. At Innsbruck admire the Golden Roof, St. Jakob's Cathedral, the Hofburg Palace and see the Olympic ski-jump during your orientation tour.

Day 8- Saturday, September 16 - INNSBRUCK – ST. MORITZ

This morning travel over the border into Switzerland and cross the enchanting Engadine.
