Small Quantity Users - To store, use or handle up to and including 500 pounds as a solid, up to and including 55 gallons as a liquid, and up to and including 200 cubic feet as a compressed gas at standard temperature and pressure (STP):

Up to 2 categories	\$203
3 or more categories	\$527

Large Quantity Users - To store or handle quantities in excess of the foregoing of any regulated materials which are categorized by Department of Transportation:

Quantity Range 1 & 2*	\$576
Quantity Range 3, 4, 5*	\$871

Closure - Close of a hazardous materials storage facility \$684

Temporary Hazardous Materials Permit - Any permit (authorized under CFC 105.6 or 105.7) issued for a time period not exceeding six (6) months. Review and Inspection, per hour (2-hour minimum). \$168
per hour

*Quantity Ranges

- 1 Up to and including 500 pounds for solids, 55 gallons for liquids and 200 cubic feet at STP for compressed gasses
- 2 Between 501 and 5,000 pounds for solids, 56 and 550 gallons for liquids and 201 and 2,000 cubic feet at STP for compressed gases
- 3 Between 5,001 and 25,000 pounds for solids, 551 and 2,750 gallons for liquids and 2,001 and 10,000 cubic feet at STP for compressed gases
- 4 Between 25,001 and 50,000 pounds for solids, 2,751 and 5,550 gallons for liquids and 10,001 and 20,000 cubic feet at STP for compressed gases
- 5 More than 50,000 pounds for solids, 5,500 gallons for liquid, and 20,000 cubic feet at STP for compressed gases

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Underground Storage Tanks

Ch. 20.60.060 SMC

Operation - To operate an underground storage tank under this title. This fee is in addition to any hazard class fee. \$102
per tank

Removal or Decommissioning - To remove or decommission any flammable liquid, combustible liquid, or hazardous chemical tank. \$501
per tank

Toxic Gases

Ch. 16.53 SMC

Storage - Store, dispense, use, or handle of toxic gases. The fee is determined by the quantity of toxic gas stored on-site. Only one of the two fees listed below will apply at each facility. This is an annual fee.

Exempt/Minimum Threshold Quantity	\$177
Class I, II, III gases below threshold quantities	\$177
Class III gases, no limit	\$177
Class I, and II gases greater than minimum threshold quantities	\$704

Closure - To review and process a closure plan for facilities using regulated gases \$627
each

Inspection / Other Fees

Consultation Fee - Review of Hazardous Materials Management Plans (HMMP's) and/or business files by consultants with Hazardous Materials Inspectors or other members of Fire Prevention Unit (minimum one half hour charge). Note: This is not intended to require a facility to pay a fee to discuss and/or review its own HMMP and/or business file. \$168
per hour

Re-inspection Fee - Each inspection following the initial inspection \$168

Overtime Inspection Fee - Hazardous material, upon request \$168

Late Application Fee - Upon failure to obtain required permit, failure to renew annual permit or failure to pay required fees; applicable 30 days after due date. 20% of bal
per month
