Sunnyvale's Program

Adopt-A-Park is a program sponsored by the City of Sunnyvale's Parks Division to enhance the condition and quality of our Parks through sponsorships and volunteer service. Adopt-A-Park offers groups and organizations the opportunity to take an active role in the beautification of our community and help support the City's Park system.

The Adopt-A-Park agreement is for one year and is renewable at the end of the sponsorship period.



What do volunteers do?

Volunteers may:

- Perform Special Projects
- Plant flowers, native plants, trees
- Leaf Raking
- Painting
- Staining of bridges, benches, etc.
- Remove Graffiti
- Spread mulch
- Clean Playgrounds
- Litter Pickup



Volunteers receive 150 hours of service in their adopted park during the year.

Recognition

After 150 hours of service, the City will place a sign at the Park bearing the name of the adopting group.



Who is Eligible?

Any group from the entire community is welcome to get involved, including community groups, service clubs, schools, faith-based organizations, neighborhood associations, and youth groups.
