1. Summary of Joint Cities Feasibility Study/Alternatives Analysis
Funding Efforts

Sunnyvale staff reported on the outcome of efforts to secure funding for a Trail Feasibility Study/Alternatives Analysis.

2. Feasibility Study/Alternatives Analysis Funding Strategies

Sunnyvale staff presented possible options for securing funding for a Trail Feasibility Study/Alternatives Analysis, or for focusing the scope of a study. After discussion, the Working Team indicated support for applying for Water District Watershed Stewardship Program funding for a focused scope Study. Working Team members will also individually

investigate the potential for utilizing their individual cities' Transportation Development Act Article 3 fund allocations for a funding swap with the City of Sunnyvale. Sunnyvale staff will also consider circulating a Request for Information on a reduced scope study in order to gauge the level of funding required.

INFORMATION ONLY ITEMS

1. City of Cupertino Stevens Creek Trail Blackberry Farm to Stevens Creek Boulevard Project Update

Cupertino staff summarized funding, scope and schedule information for extension of the Stevens Creek Trail through the Blackberry Farm golf course and Stockmeir Farm to Stevens Creek Boulevard.

2. City of Mountain View Stevens Creek Trail Dale/Heatherstone Trail Extension Contract Award

Mountain View staff summarized funding, scope and schedule information for the pending construction of a Stevens Creek Trail extension from Sleeper Avenue to Heatherstone Avenue. A groundbreaking will be held on March 5, 2011.
