CITY OF MOUNTAIN VIEW SHORELINE & STEVENS CREEK TRAIL VISITOR INFORMATION

Shoreline is open from 6:00 A.M. to one-half hour after sunset. Motor vehicles are allowed in designated parking lots and roadways only. Groups of 50 persons or more must have a permit.

The Following Activities Are Prohibited

- Harming or disturbing wildlife and plants, and feeding animals.
- Assembly of structures, commercial vending or posting of signs.

Special Provisions for Trails

Trail users are permitted on developed trails only. Trail users must limit speed to trail conditions and pass with caution. Trails and underpasses may be closed due to seasonal flooding. Stateboarding is prohibited.
