

What Goes in Your Recycling Cart?

Blue-Lid Side of Recycling Cart

Metal food and beverage containers

- Aluminum Cans
- Aluminum foil (clean)
- Bi-metal cans and lids
- Steel

Glass food and beverage containers

- Beverage bottles
- Canning jars
- Jam/peanut butter jars
- Olive oil, vinegar bottles
- Soup, spaghetti jars
- Wine bottles (no corks, metal/plastic wraps)

Plastic containers-bottles and tubs

- Baby wipes tubs
- Cottage cheese containers/lids
- Detergent bottles
- Margarine tubs
- Gallon Milk Jugs
- Peanut butter jars
- Plastic bottles (water, soda & juice)
- Plastic milk jugs (gallon/half gallon)
- Plastic detergent, juice bottles
- Prescription bottles
- Shampoo bottles
- Syrup bottles
- Yogurt tubs

Rinse containers to avoid contamination

Items Not Collected

- Aerosol cans
- Antifreeze
- Black plastics of any kind
- Ceramics & porcelain
- Crystal
- Mirrors
- Motor oil mixed with other liquid
- Plastics other than bottles, jars, tubs, cups listed - **No Hard Plastics**
- Plastic bags
- Plastic film, stretch/shrink wrap
- Pyrex
- Styrofoam of any kind
- Toys
- Wax/plastic coated cardboard
- Window/auto glass/crushed glass

Lids can be recycled if they are same material as container.



Green-Lid Side of Recycling Cart

Mixed Paper, Newspaper, Phone Books

- Colored and White paper
- Gift Wrap paper (no metallics)
- Manila folders
- Newspapers and inserts
- Paperback books
- Paperboard (notepad backing)
- Cereal, cake, tissue boxes
- Phone books
- Slick/Glossy paper
- Pamphlets, magazines, brochures
- Catalogs, junk mail

Items Not Collected

- Foil (metallic gift wrap and cards)
- Food/Beverage contaminated paper
- Frozen food boxes
- Milk, ice cream, juice cartons
- Paper cups, plates or napkins
- Pizza boxes
- Tyvek envelopes (padded envelopes)
- Waxed paper or cartons
