# FOAM FOOD CONTAINER ORDINANCE

## EXPANDED POLYSTYRENE

The City of Sunnyvale is conducting a study issue on banning the use of foam food containers (expanded polystyrene) from food establishments to further the City's Zero Waste Policy's goals, reduce storm water pollution into the Bay, and eliminate a "reasonably anticipated" carcinogenic product from Sunnyvale. The ordinance would:

- Prohibit food service vendors from distributing foam food and beverage takeout containers.
- Non-foam plastic, aluminum and compostable takeout containers will still be allowed for use.

Meetings will be held to take input from the public regarding the foam food container study issue.
