

Q: How do I download and read *By the Bay* on my laptop or desktop?

For your Windows desktop computer or laptop use:

- [Bluefire eReader](#)

OR

- [Adobe Digital Editions \(ADE\) version 2.0 for Windows*](#) (Later versions of this software are not recommended due to privacy concerns.)

Mac users can download:

- [Adobe Digital Editions \(ADE\) version 2.0 for Macintosh*](#) (Later versions of this software are not recommended due to privacy concerns.)

*If this is your first time using ADE or Bluefire Reader, you'll need to complete Adobe Activation by [creating an Adobe ID](#).

Once you've installed and authorized Bluefire Reader or ADE, you will be able to click on the ePUB file link and *By the Bay* will download and open in your Bluefire Reader or Adobe Digital Editions.

Q: How do I download and read *By the Bay* on my Android tablet or smartphone?

Option 1:

- Download [Bluefire Reader App](#) for Android

AND

- Create an [Adobe ID](#)

If this is your first time using Bluefire Reader, you will be asked to authorize the reader with your Adobe ID and password.

Once you've installed and authorized Bluefire Reader with an Adobe ID, you will be able to click on the ePUB file link and *By the Bay* will download and open in your Bluefire Reader.

Option 2:

- If you already have the [OverDrive App](#) installed on your device, you will be able to click on the ePUB file link and designate OverDrive as the program with which to open the file.

Q: How do I download and read *By the Bay* on my iPad or iPhone?

Option 1:

- [Bluefire Reader App](#) for iPad or iPhone

Once you've installed Bluefire Reader, you will be able to click on the ePUB file link and a dialogue box will open asking you to "Open in." Click on "Open in" and select Bluefire Reader.

Option 2:

- If you already have the [OverDrive App](#) installed on your device, you will be able to click on the ePUB file link and designate OverDrive as the program with which to open the file.

Q: How do I download and read *By the Bay* on a NOOK device or Sony Reader?

Option 1:

- Transfer ePUB file to your Nook or Sony Reader using Adobe Digital Editions (ADE).
 1. Open the *By the Bay* ePUB file the Adobe Digital Editions (ADE) on your Windows or Mac computer. It should be added to your library.
 2. Connect the eReader to your computer with the included USB cable.
 3. Make sure Adobe Digital Editions is in "Library" view. Your eReader should show up under "Devices."
 4. Click on an ePUB file and drag it over to your device. Once the transfer is complete, you can disconnect your device and start reading.

Option 2:

- Load the file onto your device directly.

For NOOK:

1. Connect your NOOK to your computer with the included USB cable.

2. Download and save the *By the Bay* ePUB file to a folder on your computer.
3. Open "My Computer" on Windows or look at the desktop on your Mac. The NOOK will show up as a drive where the hard drive and other USB drives appear. Double-click on the NOOK drive to open it.
4. In another window, open the folder where you saved the *By the Bay* ePUB file.
5. Drag and drop the ePUB file from your computer to the "My Documents" folder of your NOOK device.
6. Once the transfer is complete, you can disconnect your device and start reading.

For Sony Reader:

1. Download and save the *By the Bay* ePUB file to a folder on your computer.
2. Open the Sony Reader program on your computer. In Reader, click on the "File" > "Import Files" options on the top menu bar, and navigate to where you saved the *By the Bay* ePUB file. Click "Open," and the book will load into your library.
3. Now connect your eReader to your computer using the included USB cable. (Note: be sure to open the Reader software before you plug in your device).
4. Tap the "Data Transfer Mode" bar on your Sony eReader device.
5. Your eBooks will automatically begin syncing between your library and your Sony Reader.
6. Once the transfer is complete, you can disconnect your device and start reading.

Q: How do I download and read *By the Bay* on a Kindle device?
