



2010 CENSUS INFORMATION FOR SUNNYVALE

POPULATION

- **TOTAL POPULATION.** From 2000 to 2010, Sunnyvale’s total population grew by 6% from 131,760 to 140,081 persons. This growth is similar to Santa Clara County, but less than California’s 9% population increase.
- **GENDER.** Overall, 1,039 (1%) more males than females live within Sunnyvale. This compares to 6,060 (less than 1%) within Santa Clara County.
- **AGE.** As of 2010, Sunnyvale’s largest resident population is made up of residents between the ages of 30 and 39. Sunnyvale continues to support a relatively younger population as its 0-39 age range totals 58% of the overall population which is similar to California’s 57% of the same age range.
- **ETHNICITY.** Population within the Asian and “some other race” showed large increases in Sunnyvale. There continues to be an increase in Sunnyvale’s Hispanic population.


HOUSING

- **TOTAL HOUSING.** Sunnyvale’s total housing units grew by 4% from 53,753 units in 2000 to 55,791 units in 2010. This growth in housing units is lower than Santa Clara County (12% increase) and California (11% increase).
- **VACANCY RATES.** In 2010, 4.3% of all housing units were vacant compared with 2.3% in 2000. This is similar to Santa Clara County’s total vacant housing unit increase of 2% between the same time period. Vacancy rates fluctuate and are typically 3% or less.
- **RENTER-OCCUPIED.** A large increase in renter occupied housing occurred with 70,337 renters in 2010 compared to 63,968 renters in 2000.
- **AVERAGE HOUSEHOLD SIZE.** The average household size within owner occupied housing units remained consistent with 2.69 persons per housing unit (an increase of 0.01). The average household size for rented housing units increased by 0.20 to total 2.53 persons per housing unit.




Population by Gender




2010 Population by Age Group




2010 Occupied Housing




People per Square Mile by Census Tract




Sunnyvale Population 1970 to 2010


One-Race Breakdown








Population Density by Census Tract




2010 Census: United States Profile

U.S. Race* Breakdown




Population by Sex and Age






Housing Tenure
