

### **Land Use and Transportation Element (LUTE): Horizon 2035 Revival**

The email sent to committee members provides highlights of what has happened in the City since their last meeting, and notes that there is still work to be done on the Land Use and Transportation Element (LUTE). A few key milestones:

- Administrative Draft of the EIR for the LUTE and CAP was prepared by the City's consultant PMC. Results of the traffic analysis suggested more detailed review of the data and the methodologies was needed.
- Progress was made with the Lawrence Station Area Plan (LSAP) and its committee (the Community Advisory Group – CAG); a preliminary land use plan was developed and staff has worked with the consultant on the Administrative Draft of the plan.
- The Peery Park Specific Plan (PPSP) showed progress through the hiring of a consultant; two community workshops and meetings were held with staff and major property owners in Peery Park. Preliminary land use concepts have been reviewed with the community.
- Both the LSAP and the PPSP had the same issues related to the traffic analyses.
- The City had a new traffic analysis completed and is currently working with the consultant for the final pieces to move all three of these planning projects forward.
- The City Council adopted the Climate Action Plan (CAP) in May of this year (modified to reflect the current General Plan) and adopted a work plan for implementation of the CAP in November 2014.

Staff has inquired about the committee members' availability for getting back together in late January to revive and complete their efforts. Staff expects to schedule a few meetings in the upcoming months, which will be discussed at the next Horizon 2035 meeting.
