



## **COMMUNITY MEETING UPDATE TO GREEN BUILDING PROGRAM FOR RESIDENTIAL AND NON-RESIDENTIAL BUILDINGS**

The City will be hosting two meetings to discuss this study and consider possible modifications to the proposed update. The same material will be discussed at both meetings and will provide members of the public with opportunities to ask questions and provide feedback about the study.

The City adopted the green building program in 2009, establishing LEED and Build It Green levels for commercial and residential projects, respectively. There have been periodic amendments to these standards since 2009, as was contemplated when the program was first adopted. The current effort is the latest update to the program.

Staff presented updated standards to the City Council on May 6, 2014, including raising the required green building standards for new developments and additions and major alterations to existing buildings. At that City Council meeting, concerns were raised about the proposed increases, timing of the changes, and the effect the new standards would have on projects with Planning approval but not yet submitted for a building permit. The existing and proposed standards are included with this flyer.
