Exploring Inclement Weather Cold Weather Shelter Usage at County-Owned Property Located at 999 Hamlin Court, Sunnyvale

To meet the needs of unsheltered individuals during weather this winter, the County is exploring the use of 999 Hamlin Court in Sunnyvale as an emergency shelter during any declared Inclement Weather Episodes for this Cold Weather Shelter season only.

Use of the property could mitigate the impacts of El Niño which is expected to increase precipitation and bring cooler temperatures to parts of California, including the Bay Area. The heaviest precipitation associated with El Niño typically occurs between January and March. This emergency shelter program will provide overnight shelter and meals along with restrooms and shower facilities to individuals and families.

The goal of this program is to meet the basic needs of homeless individuals/families on a nightly basis. Participants must leave at a designated time each morning.
