

COMMUNITY MEETING NOTICE

SINGLE-USE PLASTIC BAG ORDINANCE

The City of Sunnyvale is proposing to adopt a single-use plastic bag ordinance in order to reduce the environmental impacts related to the use of plastic and paper carryout bags, and to promote a shift toward the use of reusable bags. The ordinance would:

- Prohibit specific types of retail establishments in Sunnyvale from providing "single-use plastic carryout bags" to customers at the point of sale and,
- Create a mandatory 15 cent charge for each paper bag distributed by those stores.

Community meetings will be held to take input from the public regarding the Environmental Impact Report (EIR) the City is preparing. As directed by the City Council, the EIR will also evaluate an alternative in which the ordinance would apply to all retailers.
