Council approved staff recommendation to: take no action at this time and staff to participate in the County Graywater Study Group to develop a model ordinance for nominal permitting requirements for clotheswasher/single fixture systems, and return to council for consideration of ordinance changes when that work is complete, estimated to be in roughly six months.</i></p>	Continuing
DPW 09-02C	<p>Joint Powers Authority (JPA) Approach to Countywide Recycling &amp; Waste Reduction Programs and Services</p> <p><i>As of September 2009, the Santa Clara County Integrated Waste Management Program is in the process of awarding a contract for a consultant to study alternate organization structures using funds from the Countywide IWM Plan Fee.
