**APPROVAL OF MINUTES of February 25, 2008**

**PUBLIC HEARINGS/GENERAL BUSINESS**

1. **2007-1302** – Application for a Design Review to allow a 1,745 square foot two-story addition to an existing residence resulting in 3,845 square feet and 62% FAR (Floor Area Ratio) where 45% may be allowed without Planning Commission review. The property is located at **1035 Daisy Court** (near Smoke Tree Wy.) in an R-0 (Low Density Residential) Zoning District. (APN: 213-15-002) MH (***Continued from February 25, 2008***)(***Applicant requests indefinite continuance***)
  
2. **2007-1083** - Appeal of a decision by the Administrative Hearing Officer denying Special Development Permit to allow an accessory utility building (arbor) with a one-foot side-yard setback where 4 feet is required. The property is located at **1464 Yukon Drive** (near Cheyenne Drive) (APN: 323-47-025) NC
  
3. **2007-0721 - T-Mobile [Applicant] City of Sunnyvale [Owner]: Application for a Use Permit** on a 9.1 acre site to allow six antennas on a 69-foot tall tree pole and ancillary ground equipment within a 240 square foot equipment enclosure at Ponderosa Park. The property is located at **811 Henderson Avenue** (near Iris Ave.) in a P-F (Public Facility) Zoning District. (Negative Declaration)(APN: 213-27-002) SB
  
4. **2008-0097 – Downtown Sunnyvale Mixed-Use LLC [Applicant/Owner]: Application for a Special Development Permit for revisions to the Sunnyvale Town Center redevelopment project’s Redwood Square.** The property is located at **2502 Town Center Lane** (project is generally bounded by Iowa Avenue to the south, Sunnyvale Avenue to the east, Washington Avenue to the north, and Mathilda Avenue to the west.) in a DSP-18 (Downtown Specific Plan Block 18) Zoning District. (APN: 209-34-009, 010, 015, 016, 017, 018 and 209-35-001, 005, 007, 010, 011, 012) SL

- Announcement of public event with definite time and date.
- Public events that are of Planning Commission interest that occur in the City annually. (Only announce one time for the year).

### **Public Hearings – Order of Hearing as Follows:**

- Opening remarks by the applicant (if applicable).
- Speakers are requested to give their name (address is optional).
- Anyone interested in addressing the Planning Commission (may only speak one time).
- Closing remarks by the applicant (if applicable).
- Time limit of 3 minutes per person (to be extended at discretion of Chair). Please make comments brief and be prepared to provide new input.

### **Citizens to be Heard**

- Any item relevant to the Planning Commission.
- Speakers are requested to give their name (address is optional).
- Speakers are to turn in a Speaker Card to the Recording Secretary.
- Items not on the agenda.
- Items that do not fall within the scope of the Public Announcement section.
- Time limit of 3 minutes, 15 minutes total for this category (to be extended or continued to end of Planning Commission business, at the discretion of the Chair). Limit to one appearance during this section.
