- Response to public concerns raised during the June BPAC meeting:
  1. Central Expressway/Bernardo Avenue bike detection - This item was reported to the County and County staff indicated that they would check detection and mark the detection zone.
  2. El Camino Real pavement - Caltrans has been contacted repeatedly over the past three years, paving is currently scheduled for 2018 but has been subject to deferral.
  3. Washington paving condition - The condition described appeared to be part of utility trenching work, as the area is currently patched and flush with the curb. Staff cannot speculate if there was a hazardous condition as described, but currently it is not hazardous.
  4. Field Services was notified about potholes and debris on Mary Avenue at Central Expressway.
  5. El Camino Real/Bernardo vehicles not yielding – Department of Public Safety will conduct enforcement.

- Recognition of a special achievement.
- Announcement of public event with definite time and date.
- Public events that are of board/commission interest that occur in the City annually. (Only announce one time for the year).

### **Public Hearings – Order of Hearing as Follows:**

- Opening remarks by the applicant (if applicable).
- Speakers are requested to give their name (address is optional).
- Anyone interested in addressing the Council (may only speak one time).
- Closing remarks by the applicant (if applicable).
- Time limit of 3 minutes per person (to be extended at discretion of Chair). Please make comments brief and be prepared to provide new input.

### **Public Comments**

- Any item relevant to the Board and/or Commission
- Speakers are requested to give their name (address is optional).
- Speakers are to turn in a Speaker Card to the Recording Secretary.
- Items not on the agenda.
- Items that do not fall within the scope of the Public Announcement section.
- Time limit of 3 minutes, 15 minutes total for this category (to be extended or continued to end of Board/Commission business, at the discretion of the Chair). Limit to one appearance during this section.
