SUBJECT: Electric Car Chargers

At the Council Study Issue Workshop for 2011, the City Council ranked the study issue for Requiring Electric Car Chargers in New Residential Developments as 3 out of 4 for the Community Development Department. As electric vehicles are becoming more available and more popular, there is an increased demand for charging equipment in residential dwelling units. In order to encourage the use of electric vehicles and reduce potential barriers to homeowners installing charging equipment, the City Council is considering requiring new residential dwelling units to be pre-wired for electrical vehicle chargers.

This item has been included on the agenda for the Sustainability Commission in order to receive input and suggestions from the commissioners; no formal action is required.

This item is scheduled as an Information Only item for the Planning Commission on October 10, 2011. The City Council meeting is scheduled for November 15, 2011.
