PUBLIC ANNOUNCEMENTS

Garth Williams announced an upcoming benefit running race to benefit the Friends of the Stevens Creek Trail.

2. DISCUSSION: Study and Budget Issues Development

The Commissioners presented ideas for study and budget issues, including signs for Morse Avenue, providing a budget for Bike to Work Day, modifying Homestead Road bike lane restrictions, reverse angle parking, colored bike lanes, new bike lanes near schools, bicycle licensing program modification, bike/ped violation classes, and a bike bridge over 101 near San Tomas Creek.

The public hearing was opened. Kevin Jackson expressed support for Homestead Road bike lane modifications, consideration of a bicyclist anti-harassment ordinance, and providing alternative transportation facilities if a new community college campus is built at the Onizuka Air Force base site.

The public hearing was closed. Commissioner Gandrud offered a potential study issue of e-mailing the BPAC agenda packet.
