This memo is to inform the Arts Commission of the completion of the public art component for the Essex Property Trust project, Via, located at 615 Tasman Drive. The Commission approved the artwork for this project at the February 16, 2011, Arts Commission meeting.

For this project, the developer selected Seattle sculptor Troy Pillow. Mr. Pillow designed a large scale, sculptural water fountain made from stainless steel treated with a patina and inset with stacked glass. It is located in the turnaround on the property. Attached are photographs of the completed artwork.

The artwork, entitled "Flow," was installed on site in September 2011. However the final details of the project were just recently completed in April 2013.
