SUNNYVALE LIBRARY TO CLOSE MARCH 7 – MARCH 21 FOR RENOVATION

SUNNYVALE, Calif. – Sunnyvale Public Library will be closed to the public Sunday, March 7, through Sunday, March 21. The closure will allow the Library to install an automated materials handling system, automated materials return and self-checkout machines. No library materials will be due on the days the Library is closed.

The Library has converted its entire collection from barcode inventory technology to a radio frequency identification (RFID) system. The new RFID-controlled inventory will work with the new equipment being installed in March to improve checkouts and allow the Library to return materials to the shelves much more quickly.

The Library is located at 665 W. Olive Ave., across from City Hall. Free parking is always available, and VTA line 54 serves the Library.
