CELEBRATING EARTH DAY'S 40TH ANNIVERSARY

SUNNYVALE, Calif. – The City of Sunnyvale, with the Sunnyvale Chamber of Commerce, will present Earth Day Generations, a fortieth-year celebration of Earth Day. The special event will be held in downtown's Plaza del Sol, 200 W. Evelyn Ave., across from the CalTrain Station and Farmers Market.

This year's event, which begins at 10 a.m. on Saturday, April 24, features entertainment by the Tenor Band, ZunZun, and a special, unique generations ReFashion Show, produced by the Art Institute of California, Sunnyvale, and featuring clothing provided by Goodwill Industries of Silicon Valley. Kids can visit face painters, join arts and crafts activities, and make their own musical instrument for the Kids Plaza Parade.

For adults, there will be backyard composting and native gardening demonstrations, along with exhibits from local green businesses and organizations. The event will also host the Sunnyvale Chamber of Commerce *For the Greener Good Expo*.

Earth Day Generations will also host both a MedDrop – a safe, secure place to dispose of your outdated and unwanted medicines – and a thermometer exchange. Simply bring in your old mercury-filled thermometer in a plastic zip-sealed bag, and receive a free digital thermometer in return, limit one per household, while supplies last.
