SUNNYVALE HOME-BUYER WORKSHOPS ANNOUNCED

SUNNYVALE, Calif. – The City of Sunnyvale will present two workshops for first-time homebuyers and interested lenders and realtors on April 22, at 12:30 p.m., and again at 5:30 p.m. The workshops will provide information about the City's new First Time Home Buyer (FTHB) Loan Program, and about several new home-buyer programs offered by The Housing Trust of Santa Clara County, presented by Dan Lachman of the Housing Trust.

These workshops are open to the general public, with a target audience of prospective first-time home buyers, interested realtors and lenders serving the Sunnyvale area. The City's program is available to prospective buyers with lower or moderate incomes who currently live or work in Sunnyvale. This City assistance may be used to purchase market-rate or below-market-rate homes located in Sunnyvale. The Housing Trust's programs are available countywide. This free presentation will be held in the Sunnyvale Community Center, 550 Remington Ave.
