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SUNNYVALE TO CO-HOST TWO TRAINING COURSES FOR CHILD CARE PROFESSIONALS

SUNNYVALE, Calif. – The City of Sunnyvale, in partnership with the UC Davis Center for Excellence in Child Development, has announced two free upcoming fall workshops for child care professionals.

“Guiding Young Children” is a two-part workshop that will be held Saturday, September 18 and 25, 9 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. This course addresses the social-emotional characteristics, biological traits and environmental influences on children’s behavior. Practical suggestions for helping children manage their behavior while supporting optimal development are offered. Using observation to understand behavior, parenting styles and cultural practices will be discussed. Participants must attend both sessions.

“The Business of Family Child Care” will be held Saturday, November 6, 9 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. This course focuses on sound business practices that provide the key to successful family child care programs. This workshop highlights the necessary ingredients for effectively operating a child care business in the the home. Information from the City of Sunnyvale’s Youth, Family and Child Care Resources will also be available to providers who are interested in learning how to develop their business in Sunnyvale.

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Workshops are held at the Sunnyvale Senior Center in the Laurel Room, 550 E. Remington Drive. Participants can receive CEU Credits (Continuing Education Units) upon completion of each class. Registration is required for both workshops and specific registration dates apply.
