SUNNYVALE OPENS RECRUITMENT FOR TWO STAFF ADVISORY COMMITTEES

SUNNYVALE, Calif. — The City of Sunnyvale is recruiting members for two staff advisory committees. Applications are being accepted through December 1.

The Human Relations and Cultural Diversity Advisory Committee (HRCDAC) was formed in 2007 and makes advisory recommendations to staff on City programs, services and activities related to human relations and cultural diversity issues. Committee members help staff build relationships with cultural groups and serve as ambassadors to the broad cultural base of Sunnyvale. The committee meets five times per year.
