EXPLORE THE PATENT APPLICATION PROCESS

SUNNYVALE, Calif. – What happens to a patent application once it has been submitted to the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office? Find out at Sunnyvale Public Library as we talk about the process on October 16 from 2 p.m. to 3:30 p.m.

There are several steps in the patent examination process. Patent agent and former patent examiner Hari Kunemneni will explain the First Office Action, consisting of Objections to Informalities, rejections based on non-prior art and prior art rejections. The applicant's response and the Final Office action also will be discussed.
