## **LOVENOTES PERFORMS NOVEMBER 27 IN SUNNYVALE**

### **Internationally-ranked barbershop quartet features local singers**

SUNNYVALE, Calif. – One of the nation’s top ranked barbershop quartets, the locally-based LoveNotes Quartet, will perform a Thanksgiving weekend concert at Sunnyvale Theatre on Saturday, November 27, at 8 p.m. as part of the City’s Evenings of Cultural Arts concert series.

LoveNotes last week placed fourth in the international quartet division at the Sweet Adelines International convention. The group also garnered second place in the 2009 Harmony Sweepstakes *a cappella* competition, where they also won hearts as the “Audience Favorite.” LoveNotes has also appeared twice on America’s Got Talent.

Their shows feature a song repertoire with cross-generational appeal, including ragtime hit “Won’t you Come Home, Bill Bailey,” Frank Sinatra’s “Come Fly With Me,” Queen’s “Bohemian Rhapsody,” “Angel of Music” from *Phantom of the Opera* and Ace of Base’s “All That She Wants.”
