CHRISTMAS TREE RECYCLING IN SUNNYVALE

SUNNYVALE, Calif. – Sunnyvale residents may recycle their Christmas trees as part of the City's normal recycling collection process. Residents with curbside service may either put their tree in their yard trimmings cart – making sure the cart's lid can still close – or place it at the curbside on any regular service collection day. Extra garbage tags are not required for Christmas tree collection. Flocked and spray painted trees may be recycled.

To prepare trees for recycling, tree stands, lights and decorations must be removed. Trees must also be cut into four-foot lengths to fit in the collection truck.

Trees may also be taken to the SMaRT Station, 301 Carl Road, Sunnyvale, from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. every day except December 25 and January 1. The \$13 per cubic yard normal collection fee for green materials will be charged.

Apartment residents should contact their property manager for details about tree recycling and collection where they live.
